

MPSC aspirant found dead; cops say suicide over debt

How many lives must be lost before system changes?: CJP founder Dipke

A 25-YEAR-OLD man preparing for the Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC) competitive examinations was found dead at his rented apartment in Pune early on Wednesday. The police said preliminary investigation suggested Prathamesh Dilop Deshmukh, a native of Dha-

rashiv district, died by suicide due to financial distress.

Deshmukh had been living in Pune for the last two years preparing for the competitive examinations, the police said.

"A suspected suicide note that we have recovered indicates that financial distress and debts were the reasons for taking the extreme step. The note has a list of people he had borrowed money from. We are probing this list and also investigating the reason why he had borrowed money," said Deputy Commissioner of Police (Zone 1) Krushikesh Rawale.

According to police, investigators are examining the contents of the suicide note and speaking to Deshmukh's family members and other people

known to him as part of the inquiry.

Further details would be clear after the investigation, police officials at the Narayan Peth chowky under Vishram-baug station said.

Meanwhile, in a post on X, CJP leader Abhijeet Dipke said there are thousands of MPSC aspirants across Maharashtra who come from humble backgrounds and many of them are from small towns and remote villages.

"Preparing for these exams already demands years of hard work and enormous sacrifices. Many students move away from home, survive on limited means and spend what little their families can afford on rent, coaching, books and re-

peated attempts," he said.

"When this is compounded by exam irregularities, delays, uncertainty and a lack of accountability, the pressure can become unbearable," Dipke said, adding that for these students, a delay or failure means more rent, more expenses, more dependence on their families and "another year of their lives hanging in uncertainty."

"Students should not have to pay such a devastating price for failures in an examination system they are expected to trust. How many more students have to suffer before those responsible take accountability? How many lives must be lost before the system finally changes?" Dipke asked.

Medical student dies after falling from 10th floor; case of suspected suicide: Police

A 21-YEAR-OLD second year medical student pursuing her MBBS degree from a prominent college in Pune died after falling from the 10th floor of a residential building. Police have launched a probe into the sequence of events leading to death.

The incident took place around 12 noon at Nancy Lake Homes society in Pune's Katraj. Police have identified the deceased as Adimaya Shekhar Reddy (21), who hailed from Hyderabad and was pursuing her MBBS degree from a college in Pune.

Gaikwad of Bharti Vidyapeeth police station said, "As soon as we received information about the incident, a team from the police station rushed to the location. The death has occurred after a fall from the 10th floor of

the building where she lived. Initial probe points to this being a case of suicide. No suicide note has been found till now," Gaikwad added.

"At the time of the incident, her brother was home. We have spoken to the brother. Initial probe suggests that her exams were currently ongoing and she was under stress," he further added.

Bharti Vidyapeeth police have registered an Accidental Death Report (ADR) which is preliminary case registration for any 'unnatural death' including suicide, accident, or suspicious death under other circumstances and becomes a starting point oga probe into it, officials said.

UCI team conducts recce ahead of 2032 championship

Expressway video: Rs 4,500 fine imposed, motorised numberplate cover dismantled

THE PIMPRI-CHINCHWAD Regional Transport Office (RTO) has taken action against an SUV fitted with a motorised mechanism that can conceal its registration number while the vehicle was in motion, after a video showing the device being used on the Mumbai-Pune Expressway went viral on social media.

RTO officials traced the vehicle, bearing registration number MH 14 LN 4888, to the owner's permanent address and inspected it following the circulation of the video. Officials

found a mechanism had been installed to deliberately conceal the registration number while the vehicle was moving, with the

apparent purpose of evading automated traffic enforcement through speed cameras and e-challans. "Following the circula-

tion on social media of a video featuring vehicle MH14LN4888 on the Mumbai-Pune Expressway, Pimpri-Chinchwad RTO officials visited the vehicle owner's permanent address," Sandesh Chavan, Regional Transport Officer, Pimpri-Chinchwad, told *The Indian Express*.

The RTO has taken action against the vehicle under Sections 41, 52, 177, 182A and 179 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, and collected a fine of Rs 4,500. The mechanism installed on the SUV was also removed in the presence of officials from Pimpri-Chinchwad RTO Flying Squad No. 5.
