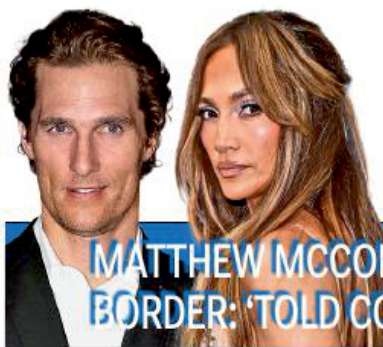

Nigel Farage beats fringe candidates in election boycotted by major parties

Nigel Farage regained his seat in parliament Friday, beating a field of fringe candidates led by trash-can-wearing comic Count Binface in a special election boycotted by mainstream parties that called it a farce. Farage, chief of Reform UK party, abruptly quit his seat in July amid an investigation into whether he failed to report a £5 million gift from an overseas billionaire. He denied wrongdoing and ran again for the seat to prove he had voters' support, regaining it with 63% of Thursday's vote in an unusual election on the hottest day of the year. Farage hailed the win as an "overwhelming win".

WWII Memorial in DC vandalised with graffiti

The WWII Memorial on the National Mall in Washington, DC, was vandalised Thursday, with bubbles filling a fountain and "Clean hands dirty S*" written in red paint. The interior department said: "Our US Park Police are on the scene and the investigation is ongoing..."

US warns Iran it will step up eco pressure; 2 ships hit in Hormuz

London/Panama City: Transit through the Strait of Hormuz appeared to grind to a near standstill Friday after two more ships were attacked there and the US said it could maintain a naval blockade of Iran indefinitely. A senior Iranian source said Wednesday that there had been no progress in talks to build on a June agreement to end the war.

As a ceasefire renewed then broke down, Iran has resumed attacks on ships it accuses of trying to transit the strait without its permission. Two vessels from the state-owned Abu Dhabi National Oil Company were attacked transiting the strait Thursday, UAE state news agency WAM reported. The UAE govt blamed Iran, which made no immediate comment. Nine vessels passed through the narrow waterway at the entrance to the Gulf Thursday, up from five Wednesday but below the average for Aug of 12, according to ship-tracking company Kpler. There were no visible crossings by vessels seen early on Friday, according to ship-tracking data.

US defence secretary Pete Hegseth, meanwhile, told reporters the US military has the capability to maintain a naval presence in the region to enforce its retaliatory blockade of Iran. "Indefinitely the US navy can maintain a blockade like that because we'll rotate ships in and out, as we have, and we'll continue to," Hegseth told reporters during a trip to Panama. Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent said US planned to inflict more financial damage on Iran. "Watch this space for more announcements coming next week because we are going to apply measures like have never been seen in the history of economic isolation on a country," he said. REUTERS

Reports of mental health issues aboard USS Lincoln

Washington: The Pacific-based aircraft carrier USS George Washington has begun heading toward West Asia as reports have emerged of mental health and supply issues aboard the long-deployed USS Abraham Lincoln.

The Lincoln has been supporting the US war against Iran, and its deployment has included a record-setting uninterrupted time at sea of more than 260 days. Several Democratic lawmakers are pressing for accountability from the Pentagon over conditions aboard the carrier, which defence secretary Pete Hegseth Thursday said were "completely misrepresented." Extended deployments of carriers have raised concerns about the impact on service members.

The Lincoln originally deployed Nov 21 from San Diego, and it arrived in West Asia in Jan. The navy conceded that

the conflict created a "highly contested environment where traditional supply hubs in West Asia were disrupted by combat actions." That, in turn, led to shortages and loss of mail aboard the aircraft carrier, the navy said in a statement.

When reports of food shortages aboard the ship first surfaced in April, the navy pushed back, calling those reports "false." Reports have since emerged that sailors on the Lincoln are struggling with mental health concerns. The navy said in its statement that it has "not observed an increase in suicidal ideations or attempts aboard the ship," but officials declined to provide data. The navy official said a sailor aboard the Lincoln went overboard in early Aug but the person was quickly recovered, treated by the ship's medical department and transferred off ship for follow-on care. Washington: Before police found his mother and younger brother dead inside their quiet suburban home in Acton, outside Boston, 17-year-old Arjun Aravind had allegedly been exploring a dark world online — using the internet and ChatGPT to search for ideas and create fictional scenarios about killing his own family.

That revelation, disclosed by local district attorney Marian Ryan, has transformed an already horrific double homicide into a case with an unsettling 21st-century dimension: the intersection of troubled youth and digital conversations on tap in the age of artificial intelligence.

Aravind is accused of killing his mother, Sudha Venkatesan, 45, and his 14-year-old brother, Siddharth Aravind, at their home on Tuesday. He faces two counts of murder, along with assault and battery and motor-vehicle charges. A not-guilty plea was entered on his behalf on Thursday, and he was ordered held without bail while undergoing a mental-health evaluation after he was brought to the court in handcuffs and leg shackles.

Ryan said Aravind had recently displayed "concerning behaviour," including using

the internet and ChatGPT to develop "theoretical ideas or fantasy stories regarding the killing of his family." She disclosed that he had created what appeared to be Gothic novel-style stories, creating characters whose circumstances seemed connected to threats against his family.

Police were summoned after Aravind's father, Sukumaran, could not reach his family, and a tutor arriving for a scheduled appointment could not get into the house. Officers found Siddharth on the first floor and his mother in the basement, both dead with trauma injuries. Aravind allegedly fled in his mother's car and was found inside the car in neighbouring Wayland early Wednesday when he was arrested without incident.

The case is jarring for Indian-American families because such killings remain rare, although there is a haunting precedent in the Washington area. In March 2005, Jayant

Kadian, then a 20-year-old college student, killed his mother, Kiran Kadian—whose husband, Rajesh Kadian, a strategic affairs commentator, was a familiar figure in think-tank circles in the Capital—at the family's Virginia home.

But what makes the Acton case especially alarming is that investigators have encountered something previous generations of cops and prosecutors could scarcely have imagined: an alleged killer leaving behind conversations with a machine about violent fantasies.

A recent study found that one in eight adolescents and young adults reported using generative AI for mental-health advice. Researchers have warned that current AI safety evaluations may miss dangers arising in real-world interactions with vulnerable youth. At the same time, social-media companies face scores of lawsuits alleging that their platforms can contribute to harmful effects on young people, allegations the companies dispute. In the Acton killings, however, the technological debate is secondary for now to a family and community tragedy. As Ryan put it, the community and the school system were entering "a very dark and long process."

Trump OKs navy to build ships abroad, orders steam catapults back on carriers

US President Trump has allowed the navy to build ships overseas and ordered it to abandon a complex system for launching jet fighters from its aircraft carriers and instead return to using steam catapults, the White House said Thursday.

Trump signed a national security memorandum directing the change, which would require the fourth vessel in the Gerald R. Ford class of aircraft carriers to abandon the Electromagnetic Aircraft Launch System (EMALS) used on the first three vessels. The design change is expected to cost tax-

payers hundreds of millions of dollars.

Trump has frequently criticised the navy's electromagnetic launch system as being more expensive and not as effective as steam catapults. "Billions of dollars more they spent on electric catapults and they're not good. They're not nearly as good, too complex," Trump said at a summit in Pennsylvania last month.

General Atomics, the maker of EMALS, said in a statement that the decision not to proceed with the system on the Doris Miller warranted "careful reconsideration." REUTERS

US to impose tariffs on drone imports: WH

President Trump said Thursday he will impose tariffs on imports of drones and their components, with the administration saying the country was "too reliant" on foreign sources. A proclamation signed by Trump imposes a 100% ad valorem tariff on drones of certain capabilities, the White House said. A 15% tariff will be imposed on drones and components from the EU, Japan, Liechtenstein, South Korea, Switzerland, and Taiwan, the White House added. REUTERS

France's top court blocks social media ban for U-15s

Paris: France's top court on Friday blocked a bill banning social media access for under-15s, saying it infringed upon freedom of expression, a setback for President Emmanuel Macron, who asked his govt to rewrite the legislation. "By prohibiting minors under the age of fifteen from accessing certain online services, the law inherently requires every person, even an adult, to prove their age before accessing them," the constitutional council said in its decision.

"However, by failing to specify the conditions and limits under which such proof must

be provided, the legislature has not established the legal safeguards necessary to ensure compliance with these requirements," it added.

French lawmakers had approved a ban on social media access for children under age 15, becoming the first in Europe to follow Australia, whose world-first ban barred access to platforms including Facebook, TikTok and YouTube for under-16s in Dec. Macron has ordered PM Sebastian Lecornu to rework the draft legislation to take the constitutional council's concerns into account, the Elysee said. REUTERS

Italian police find stolen Renoir, Cezanne, Matisse

Paintings by Renoir, Cezanne and Matisse worth over \$10.4m which were stolen from an Italian museum in March have been recovered, police said Friday. The paintings were taken by thieves from the villa of the Magnani-Rocca Foundation, near Parma in northern Italy, in a heist that lasted under three minutes. Parma chief of police An-

drea Pagliaro told AFP the investigation centred around a gang of nine Moldavian suspects. Five are accused of carrying out the theft, he said. They made off with "Fish" by Auguste Renoir, "Still Life with Cherries" by Paul Cezanne, and "Odalisque on the Terrace" by Henri Matisse. The paintings were recovered at the house of one of the suspects.

Nero's Bridge emerges from river in Rome: The remains of an ancient bridge have emerged in Rome's Tiber

river, near St Peter's Basilica, as weeks with virtually no rain caused water levels to plunge. The bridge — known as Nero's Bridge, named for the former Roman emperor — once connected Rome's city centre with the Tiber's right bank. Antonella Bonini, an archaeologist at Rome's cultural heritage superintendency said, "Scholars consider the bridge to be older (than Nero's era) — built by Caligula. Nero's uncle," she said, adding that it existed as early as 39 AD.
