

Rajasthan Cabinet approves UCC, Tree Protection bills drafts; to table them in Assembly

Jaipur, Aug 13 (FN Reporter)

Rajasthan Cabinet on Thursday approved the drafts of the Rajasthan Uniform Civil Code (UCC) Bill, 2026, and the Rajasthan Trees (Protection) Bill, 2026, with both



proposed to be introduced in the upcoming Assembly session, officials said. The proposed UCC seeks to provide a uniform legal framework in the state for marriage, divorce, inheritance, maintenance and live-in relationships, while the Tree Protection Bill proposes special protection for 29 tree species, including khejri, the state tree. The cabinet meeting, chaired by Chief Minister Bhajanlal Sharma, also approved an operations and maintenance policy for rural drinking water supply and took several decisions relating to personnel welfare and ex-servicemen, according to an official statement. In a statement, Parliamentary Affairs Minister Jogaram Patel said the UCC draft was prepared on the recommendations of an expert committee headed by former Supreme Court judge Justice Ranjana Prakash Desai. Under the proposed law, registration of all marriages solemnised after its implementation would be

mandatory within 60 days and polygamy would be prohibited, Patel said. The proposed legislation would allow marriages to be solemnised according to the customs and traditions of different religions and communities, while providing a common legal framework for their registration and related matters. The

provisions of the proposed UCC would not apply to Scheduled Tribes and classes, which have constitutionally protected customary rights, the minister said. The draft also proposes registration or written intimation of the commencement and termination of live-in relationships, aimed at protecting the rights of the parties, he said. The proposed law provides for equal inheritance rights for sons and daughters, and lays down a priority order for succession in cases where a person dies without a will, according to the statement. The draft Rajasthan Trees (Protection) Bill, 2026, is aimed at regulating the felling of trees on non-forest land and protecting 29 important species. Besides khejri and rohida, the list includes banyan, peepal, lasoda, tendu, mahua, ker, and chironji. Under the proposed legislation, cutting a protected tree on non-forest land without prior permission of the competent authority would be prohibited.

A violation could attract imprisonment of up to one year, a fine of up to Rs 1 lakh, or both. Where permission is granted for removal of a tree, plantation of a prescribed number of trees in the same area would be required, officials said. The cabinet also approved an operations and maintenance policy for rural water supply schemes, incorporating the 19 major components of the Centre's Jal Jeevan Mission 2.0. gram panchayats and village water and sanitation committees would be responsible for day-to-day operation and maintenance at the local level. In another decision concerning defence personnel, the cabinet approved an amendment to extend the cut-off date for compassionate appointments to families of 35 soldiers who died of injuries sustained during the 1971 India-Pakistan war. The government said 326 Rajasthan soldiers were killed during the war, while 35 others who had suffered serious injuries died during treatment between January 1 and October 31, 1972. The amendment would make their families eligible for compassionate appointment. The cabinet approved a two-year relaxation in the requisite experience for promotions during 2026-27 for government employees who did not receive such

benefit during the previous three years. It also approved amendments providing notional benefits from June 30, 2016, for reservation in promotion for government employees with disabilities. Among other decisions, the cabinet approved inclusion of daughters-in-law of deceased government employees among eligible dependents for compassionate appointments and changes in maternity and child-care leave provisions. The cabinet also approved allotments of around 306 hectares of industrial land in Jaisalmer district to UltraTech Cement Ltd and land for four renewable energy projects in Bikaner, Jaisalmer, and Barmer districts.
