

2 more firms raided for allegedly running Ponzi schemes

The district administration on Friday conducted raids on two companies allegedly running Ponzi deposit and investment schemes by promising unusually high returns to investors. The raids were carried out under the provisions of the Karnataka Protection of Interests of Depositors (KPID) Act.

The companies raided were Growdhan, located at Guruwar Peth in Tilakwadi, and City Index Technologies and Training Solutions Private Limited, located on Mahatma Phule Road in Shahapur.

The scam cell in the deputy commissioner's office had been monitoring companies suspected of operating Ponzi schemes. Officials had also gathered market intelligence and collected information shared through various platforms, including social media.

The raids were conducted under the leadership of assistant commissioner of Belagavi subdivision Shrvan Nayak, with officials from various departments participating in the operation.

During the inspections, officials collected details related to investments made by the public, the companies' permissions and compliance with regulations of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) and other competent authorities. The process of verifying the documents and records was underway.

The City Police provided security at both locations to prevent any untoward incidents and to ensure that officials could carry out the inspections smoothly.

Based on the findings of the inquiry, cases will be registered against the companies if any violations of legal provisions or regulatory norms are established, officials said.

Clubs violating norms face closure: Police

Inspection drive launched after shooting incident

The City Police have launched a special drive to inspect clubs, gymkhana and other recreational centres across the city to ensure compliance with licensing norms and curb illegal gambling and other unlawful activities. Establishments found violating the law or licence conditions will face action, including cancellation of their licences.

The drive comes in the wake of the recent gambling and shooting incident reported at

The Union Gymkhana Limited. Police inspectors of all jurisdictional police stations have been given 10 days to complete the inspections and submit their reports.

Police Commissioner Bhushan Borase said on Friday that all police inspectors have been directed to prepare a list of clubs and recreational centres within their respective jurisdictions and verify whether they are operating with valid licences and statutory permissions.

"If any club or recreational centre is found conducting card games or similar activi-

ties, the management will be informed in writing about the conditions to be followed in accordance with the directions issued by the Karnataka High Court and the applicable laws. A written acknowledgement of these instructions will also be obtained from the persons responsible for the establishment," he said.

CCTV cameras

Borase said clubs and recreational centres must install CCTV cameras at all entry points and gaming areas, preserve the footage for at least 15 days and produce it before the police whenever required. They must issue identity cards to all members, ensure that non-members and guests are not allowed to participate in games, prohibit activities involving cash stakes, betting, gambling or any other illegal

games, and extend full co-operation to the police during inspections.

He said inspection reports would be submitted to his office within 10 days. If any establishment is found violating legal provisions or licence conditions, the police will recommend cancellation of its licence to the competent authority. Appropriate legal action will also be initiated against the violators, he warned.

Clarifying that the objective of the drive is not to inconvenience law-abiding clubs and recreational centres, Borase said the exercise is aimed at preventing illegal gambling, betting, activities that disturb public order and other unlawful practices.

He appealed to club managements and the public to co-operate with the police during the special drive.

Farmers end four-day protest after KNNL assures action on demands

Ryots' details to be sent to govt for compensation

An indefinite protest by farmers from various villages in Hukkeri taluk, whose lands were acquired for the Hidkal Dam project, ended on Friday evening after officials of the Karnataka Neeravari Nigam Limited (KNNL)

assured them that details of all affected farmers would be submitted to the government for sanctioning compensation.

The farmers, along with their family members and livestock, had been staying on the premises of the KNNL Belagavi Zonal Office since Tuesday evening, demanding compensation for nearly 400 acres of land submerged in the backwaters of the Hidkal Dam.

They said they had lost their primary source of livelihood nearly four decades ago due to land acquisition and had been awaiting compensation.

Farmers from Mastiholi, Gudagnatti, Beeranhol, Sutgatti and Jarkiholi villages in Hukkeri taluk participated in the protest, demanding adequate compensation from the government. They had also taken out a protest rally from the KNNL office to the deputy commissioner's office and held discussions with Deputy Commissioner Mohammad Roshan.

The farmers had alleged that despite directions from the KNNL secretary to submit details of the affected farmers, the zonal office had delayed

the process, forcing them to launch the protest.

The agitation ended after discussions between farmer representatives and KNNL officials, who agreed to prepare and submit a comprehensive list of all farmers who lost their land for the project to the government for further action.

Farmer leader Balesh Mavnure said, "The file will now have to be placed before the secretary and the Cabinet for approval of compensation. Farmers from 10 villages will benefit once the process is completed," he said.

Two brothers murdered over property dispute

BELAGAVI, DHNS: Two brothers were allegedly beaten to death with sticks and sharp weapons over a property dispute at Nugganatti village in Yaragatti taluk of Belagavi district late on Thursday night. Police have arrested a woman in connection with the murder and launched a search for the remaining accused.

The deceased have been identified as Basappa Ramannavar (38) and Lagmappa Ramannavar (32), both residents of Nugganatti village.

According to police, the brothers were attacked by a group of relatives following a long-standing dispute over ancestral property. They sustained grievous injuries and succumbed to them.

Preliminary investigation revealed that the deceased's elder brother, Yallappa Ramannavar, had married Avanavva about 15 years ago. However, she had been living at her parental home

for the past eight years after separating from her husband. She had been seeking a share in the family property for her son, and the family had reportedly allotted her one acre of land for cultivation.

Police said Avanavva's family had repeatedly asked the Ramannavar family to be present for the measurement and demarcation of the land. Basappa and Lagmappa allegedly failed to turn up, triggering tension between the two families.

On Thursday night, Avanavva, along with several of her relatives, allegedly attacked the two brothers with sticks and sharp weapons.

The accused include her father, two brothers and other family members. Yallappa escaped the attack as he was away from the village on work.

Superintendent of Police K Ramarajan and other senior officers visited the spot.

Murgod police have registered a case and are investigating.
