Pul Doda bridge closed after crack

Authorities have closed the Pul Doda Bridge for all vehicular traffic after a crack was noticed on the bridge amid continuous heavy rainfall in Jammu and Kashmir's Doda district. The decision was taken as a precautionary measure to ensure public safety. Police and the district administration have restricted traffic movement, while the bridge is being assessed by the concerned engineering authorities.

MPSC paper leak: CBI probe sought

NCP (SP) MLA Rohit Pawar on Monday claimed the Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC) recruitment examination for drug inspectors had suffered a paper leak.

While seeking a probe by the Central Bureau of Investigation, he also alleged that an accused in the Teachers Eligibility Test (TET) paper leak had links with the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party.

Addressing a press conference here, Pawar alleged Maharashtra had witnessed several examination paper leak cases in recent years, including those related to the TET, NEET, State Reserve Police Force (SRPF) and the Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) drug inspector recruitment examination.

"The entire MPSC (drug inspector recruitment) paper may not have been leaked, but the person who set the paper

was compromised. The question paper was allegedly shared with candidates through WhatsApp and deleted within five minutes. The matter came to light after one of the recipients forwarded the questions to a friend," he claimed.

Pawar alleged that students had submitted a complaint to the MPSC on July 21 but no action was taken. Instead, they were allegedly threatened with police action, the NCP (SP) MLA added.

He also questioned how the son and daughter of a deputy tehsildar secured 13th and 16th ranks, respectively, in the examination.

The NCP (SP) has found a "Barshi connection" in the alleged irregularities, he said while seeking an independent investigation.

"The MPSC and Food and Drug Administration (FDA) should immediately probe the allegations and transfer the case to the Central Bureau of

Investigation (CBI), he said.

"We had earlier submitted evidence regarding irregularities in the Talathi recruitment to the chief minister, but nothing happened.

Later, the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal observed that 62 fraudulent candidates had been identified in the Talathi recruitment process," he claimed. Referring to the TET examination scam, Pawar alleged that some of the accused were linked to the BJP.

"One of the accused in the TET scam is associated with the BJP and also handles the financial affairs of one of its leaders," he claimed, though he did not name the leader.

Petrol bomb hurled at Sangrur BJP office

Chandigarh: A petrol bomb was hurled by some unidentified persons at the BJP office in Punjab's Sangrur district, police said on Monday. Police said that efforts were on to trace the culprits.

Upon receiving information, a team of senior police officials reached the BJP office located at Uppli Road. Following inspection of the site, it appeared that an ignited petrol-filled bottle was thrown towards the building from the outer wall, police said.

Relief for Azam Khan as demolition stayed

In a big relief to Mohammad Ali Jauhar University, founded by Samajwadi Party leader and former MP Azam Khan, the Uttar Pradesh government's Divisional Commissioner has stayed, for now, the demolition order issued against 38 campus buildings by the District Magistrate of Rampur, an official said on Monday.

The Divisional Commissioner has directed the Rampur district administration to maintain status quo till the next hearing, thus putting

the brakes on bulldozers heading towards the campus.

The controversy over Jauhar University erupted after the Rampur Development Authority (RDA) flagged multiple violations inside the varsity, claiming that 38 out of 40 buildings were made without necessary approvals.

The RDA had also asked the University to remove them on its own within a time frame, failing which the district administration will step in to raze them.

Earlier last week, a group of SP leaders and workers hit the streets in Ayodhya in protest against the Rampur

Development Authority's order to demolish 38 out of 40 campus buildings, allegedly built without approved sanctioned plans.

They submitted a memorandum, addressed to the President of India, to the city's District Magistrate and demanded a halt to the proposed flattening of the varsity buildings. In the memorandum, the SP workers have sought his intervention against the proposed action against Jauhar University and insisted that all parties be given an opportunity to present their case in accordance with legal procedures.
