

# RGU Celebrates National Handloom Day with Industry– Academia Connect



**The Assam Rising, Guwahati, August 8 :** The Assam Royal Global University (RGU) on Friday celebrated National Handloom Day 2026 with an Industry– Academia Connect programme that brought together leading fashion entrepreneurs, designers, handloom experts, artisans and students to explore the future of sustainable fashion, entrepreneurship and India's rich textile heritage. The programme was organised by the Royal School of Fashion Design and Technology (RSFT) in collaboration with the Institution's Innovation Council and Entrepreneurship Cell (IIC-EC), with support from the Foundation for MSME

Clusters (FMC).The programme featured internationally acclaimed fashion entrepreneur and designer Robert Naorem from Manipur; Shri Jayanta Dev Sharma, former Deputy Director, Handloom & Textiles, Government of Assam; Anoushka Das, Founder of Studio Anurupa Private Limited and Anushka Annasuya; and Barsha, Founder of Ezaar Collective, who shared their experiences on building successful creative enterprises rooted in indigenous crafts. Addressing the gathering, Dr. Sriparna Bhuyan Baruah, Director,

IIC-EC, said National Handloom Day is not only a celebration of India's centuries-old textile traditions but also an opportunity to encourage innovation, sustainability and entrepreneurship in the handloom sector. She said the University seeks to inspire students to develop technology-driven solutions, ethical business models and sustainable enterprises that empower weavers and preserve traditional craftsmanship. A key attraction was an interactive session titled "Craft to Commerce – Innovation, Entrepreneurship & Building Sustainable Enterprises". Students

actively participated in the discussion through an open-house question-and-answer session with the

experts and artisans.Traditional artisans from Pairanga, Boko, demonstrated Eri silk weaving and natural dyeing, while artists from Majuli showcased the intricate art of Assamese manuscript painting, giving students first-hand exposure to some of Assam's finest indigenous craft traditions.An exhibition of Eri silk products developed by weavers from Pairanga under the Cisco CSR Project drew considerable attention, allowing participants to interact directly with the artisans and appreciate the craftsmanship behind the products.The programme also explored future collaboration between FMC and RGU's Innovation Council and Entrepreneurship Cell through student internships, live industry projects, innovation challenges, design collaborations and field immersion programmes.

# Review Meeting on Flood Situation Held in Nazira Under Minister Kaushik Rai

**The Assam Rising, Nazira,August 8:** A review meeting on the recent flood situation in Nazira was held on Thursday at the conference hall of the Nazira Co-District Commissioner's office, chaired by Assam Minister Kaushik Rai, who oversees the departments of Food, Public Distribution and Consumer Affairs, as well as Housing and Urban Affairs.During the meeting, the minister assessed the extent of damage caused by floods in the affected areas under Nazira, Simaluguri, and Amguri municipalities. He directed the concerned officials to prioritize the cleaning of drains and sewer systems, proper disposal of waste, and restoration of essential municipal services to bring normalcy back at the earliest.Rai also reviewed the functioning of the Food, Public Distribution and Consumer Affairs Department. He took stock of the availability and



distribution of essential ration supplies in flood-affected areas and instructed departmental officials to assess ration cards that may have been damaged due to the floods.The meeting was attended by Nazira MLA Mayur Borgohain, CDC of Nazira Pratibha Meshram, Commissioner and Secretary of Housing and Urban Affairs Kavita Padmanabhan, Director of

Municipal Administration Tonkeshwar Das, Commissioner of Food, Public Distribution and Consumer Affairs Hemanta Bhuyan, Joint Secretary of Assam Food and Civil Supplies Corporation Parijat Bhuyan, and chairpersons of Nazira, Simaluguri, and Amguri municipalities—Barnali Chetia, Kabita Mili, and Anamika Neog Vaishya—along with senior officials from various departments.

# Lightning strikes hotel in Tezpur; guest escapes unhurt

**The Assam Rising, Tezpur,August 8:** A guest staying at a hotel here had a narrow escape after lightning struck the building late on Thursday night, even as several business establishments in the vicinity suffered damage to electrical appliances and equipment in the incident. The lightning strike occurred around midnight, amid heavy rainfall, in the heart of Tezpur town. According to sources, the outer wall of Room No. 101,

located on the first floor of Hotel Park, was struck by lightning, which shattered the concrete structure and sent sparks flying into the room. The guest present in the room at the time escaped unhurt. Hotel sources said that adequate lightning-protection measures were in place at the establishment. However, the intensity of Thursday night's lightning strike split open a concrete pillar of the hotel's boundary wall, with sparks spreading

into the interior of the building, an occurrence that left staff and guests alike stunned. The strike damaged 12 ceiling fans and a generator, besides other electrical equipment, on the hotel premises. Several other business establishments located near the hotel also reported damage to their electrical appliances as a result of the lightning strike. No other injuries were reported in the incident.

# Dhubri School Hosts Anti-Drug Awareness Drive, 700 Students Take Pledge for Addiction-Free Life

**The Assam Rising, Dhubri, August 8:** An anti-drug awareness session was organised at PM Shri Dhubri Government Girls' Higher Secondary School on August 7, where around 700 students pledged to lead an addiction-free life. The initiative was projected by the Dhubri unit of Prajapita Brahma Kumaris Ishwariya Vishwa Vidyalaya as part of a nationwide campaign aimed at discouraging substance abuse among young people.The programme formed part of the "10-Crore Addiction-Free Pledge Mega Campaign," being held across the country from August 6 to August 20, 2026. The campaign involves participation from more than 5,500 branches of the organisation and seeks to inspire youth to stay away from harmful substances and adopt healthier lifestyles. The awareness drive is being carried out in collaboration with the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment under the Nasha Mukti Bharat Abhiyaan and Mission

SPANDAN. These initiatives focus on educating communities, especially adolescents, about the risks and long-term consequences of substance abuse. According to Academic In-Charge Biswajit Sarkar, students from Classes 6 to 12 attended the session, which emphasised the importance of awareness, discipline and collective responsibility in preventing addiction. Speakers at the event highlighted how substance abuse can negatively impact physical health, mental well-being and academic performance. Subject teacher Purnima Saikia addressed the gathering, stressing the vital role that educational institutions and spiritual organisations play in guiding young minds. She underlined the need for early intervention, awareness programmes and community support systems to protect students from falling into

addiction.The session included interactive discussions that encouraged students to reflect on the dangers of drug use and the importance of making responsible life choices. Organisers aimed to create a supportive environment where students could openly engage with the issue and understand its broader social implications.At the conclusion of the programme, all participating students took a collective pledge to stay away from drugs and other harmful substances. They also committed to spreading awareness among their peers and contributing to the creation of an addiction-free environment within their schools and communities. Organisers stated that the initiative is intended to connect local educational institutions with the broader national movement against substance abuse, while empowering students to become ambassadors of positive change and responsible citizenship.

# Kamrup Metro Orders Flyover Safety Checks, Tightens E-Rickshaw Rules Amid Rising Road Safety Concerns

**The Assam Rising, Guwahati, August 8:** The Kamrup Metropolitan District Road Safety Committee has issued a series of directives aimed at improving road safety and traffic management in Guwahati, with a focus on flyover inspections, e-rickshaw regulation, and enhanced passenger safety measures for round-the-clock establishments. The decisions were taken during a committee meeting held at the conference hall of the District Commissioner's Office under the chairmanship of District Commissioner Swapnil Paul. The meeting was attended by key officials, including District Development Commissioner Manjit Barkakati, Additional District Commissioner Raja Baishya, Member Secretary Abhijit Choudhury, ADCP Traffic-2 Minmoy Goswami, Regional Transport Authority Secretary Tamsin Aftab, District Transport Officer Himanshu Kumar Das, and representatives

from multiple departments such as Public Works, Health, and Excise.At the outset, the District Commissioner reviewed the progress of decisions made during previous meetings, with particular emphasis on strengthening road safety across the city. One of the major concerns discussed was the frequent skidding of two-wheelers on the Maharaja Prithu Flyover, especially during the rainy season. Taking note of the issue, Paul directed the concerned sub-committee to conduct regular inspections of all flyovers and ensure timely maintenance to prevent accidents.The committee also deliberated extensively on the growing number of e-rickshaws in the city and the need for better regulation. Officials were instructed to adopt a more structured and rational

approach to managing e-rickshaw movement to ensure smoother traffic flow and reduce congestion in key areas.In addition, the meeting reviewed safety measures for customers of bars and hotels operating 24x7. These establishments were instructed to strictly comply with existing guidelines mandating pick-up and drop-off facilities for patrons. The Excise Department and the District Transport Officer (Enforcement) were directed to maintain constant vigilance and ensure that these measures are properly implemented.The committee underscored the importance of coordination among various government departments and stressed the need for practical, timely interventions to address road safety challenges. The directives are expected to enhance commuter safety and bring greater discipline to traffic management in Guwahati.
