

Govt gives nod to RBI for field trials of Rs 10 and Rs 20 polymer currency notes

NEW DELHI, July 27 (IANS)

THE Finance Ministry informed Parliament on Monday that the Government has approved the Reserve Bank of India's (RBI) proposal to conduct field trials of polymer currency notes in the Rs 10 and Rs 20 denominations.

The approval was confirmed by Minister of State for Finance Pankaj Chaudhary in a written reply to a question in the Lok Sabha.

The Government, however, clarified that the move does not signal the end of paper currency. Polymer banknotes are proposed to circulate alongside existing paper notes, and there is no proposal to phase out paper-based banknotes in favour of



polymer currency.

The Reserve Bank will issue billion pieces each of Rs 10 and Rs 20 polymer currency notes as part of the field trials to be carried out in the country.

The RBI has proposed introducing the polymer notes on a trial basis to evaluate their performance under Indian conditions. A wider rollout will be considered only if the field trials are

successful, according to the Government's response.

The central bank has argued that polymer banknotes are more durable than conventional paper currency.

Citing international experience, the RBI said polymer notes have a longer lifespan, making them suitable for economies with high cash circulation.

Lower currency denominations wear out quickly and require frequent reprinting and destruction; plastic notes reduce waste and long-term replacement costs.

Polymer substrates allow for advanced anti-counterfeiting features like transparent see-through windows and specialized security threads.

Global crude oil prices plunge up to 7 pc

NEW DELHI, July 27 (IANS)

GLOBAL crude oil prices witnessed heavy selling pressure on Monday, with key oil benchmarks plunging up to 7 per cent after the United States and Iran paused military strikes over the weekend. International benchmark Brent crude fell more than 7 per cent or about \$7 to hover around the \$91-a-barrel mark.

On the other hand, US West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude also declined over 7 per cent, shedding around \$6.4 to trade below \$85 a barrel.

The sharp decline came after Iran indicated it would refrain from further attacks as long as the US also halted military operations.



tions, fuelling expectations that the conflict could move towards a diplomatic resolution.

The latest resolution follows a sharp rally in oil prices over the past three weeks, during which Brent briefly crossed the \$100-

a-barrel mark amid fears that the conflict would disrupt crude supplies through the Strait of Hormuz and the Bab el-Mandeb Strait two of the world's most critical energy shipping routes.

Sensex jumps 776 points on sharp drop in crude oil prices

MUMBAI, July 27 (PTI)

STOCK markets snapped the five-day losing streak on Monday, with the benchmark Sensex jumping by 776 points following a sharp decline in crude oil prices amid easing tensions in West Asia. The 30-share BSE Sensex jumped 776.01 points, or 1.02 per cent, to settle at 76,835.78. During the day, it soared 841.74 points, or 1.10 per cent, to 76,901.51.

The 50-share NSE Nifty surged 228.50 points, or 0.96 per cent, to end at 23,995.95, ending its five-day losing trend. Among Sensex firms, Eternal jumped the most by 5.70 per cent. InterGlobe Aviation, Infosys, Bajaj Finance, Asian Paints and Mahindra & Mahindra were also among the gainers. HDFC Bank, Power Grid and Axis Bank were the laggards. Brent crude, the global oil benchmark, tanked 9.40 per cent to USD 87.64 per barrel. "A pause in strikes in West Asia has eased concerns over rising import costs and inflation, triggering a relief rally in markets. The sharp correction in crude oil prices,

along with a decline in long-term bond yields, has also raised hopes of a durable resolution, supported by signs of long unwinding," Vinod Nair, Head of Research, Geojit Investments Limited, said. Foreign Institutional Investors (FIIs) offloaded equities worth Rs 3,892.77 crore on Friday, according to exchange data. "After five consecutive sessions of losses, the Indian stock market closed on a positive note, supported by broad-based buying and improving global sentiment. Investor confidence strengthened as easing Iran-US tensions pushed crude oil prices lower, reducing inflation concerns for India," Gaurav Garg, Analyst, Lemonn Markets Desk, said.

The BSE SmallCap Select index jumped 1.71 per cent and MidCap Select index climbed 1.65 per cent.

MidSmall Private Banks Quality Tilt jumped the most by 2.36 per cent, followed by IT (2.30 per cent), Realty (2.25 per cent), Focused IT (2.09 per cent), Services (2 per cent), Auto (1.53 per cent) and Hospitals (1.43 per cent). Telecommunication emerged as the only laggard. A total of 2,776 stocks advanced.
