Telangana CM and Minister perform ritual for better rain

As the prospect of deficit rainfall looms large with less than two months remaining for the monsoon to recede, the Telangana government conducted *Varuna Yagam*, the traditional worship to invoke the blessings of Varuna – the rain God, in the Krishna and Godavari catchment areas on Monday. Irrigation Minister N. Uttam Kumar Reddy initiated the sacred ritual, performed with 108 priests on 11 sacred altars, at Nagarjunasagar early on Monday morning.

T.G. Mohandas granted bail in case over derogatory remarks

The Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Court in Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, on Monday granted bail to Hindutva ideologue T.G. Mohandas in a case related to alleged derogatory remarks he made in a YouTube video against students who protested at Jantar Mantar in Delhi. The court granted him conditional bail after directing him to appear before the investigating officer for three consecutive days and fully cooperate with the investigation.

Ex-Armyman killed as SUV rams two-wheelers

A 47-year-old former Army Subedar was killed and two others injured after an SUV hit three two-wheelers in Hydershakote, Telangana, early on Monday. The SUV was allegedly being driven on the wrong side of the road. The ex-Subedar, sustained fatal injuries and died at the spot. Two other two-wheeler riders were injured and shifted to a hospital for treatment. Police have registered a case and launched an investigation into the hit-and-run incident.

SC agrees to early hearing of T.N.'s plea in Cauvery dispute

Deficit in allocation of river water has left farmers in perilous situation, says T.N.; it sought judicial direction to Karnataka to implement CWMA decision to ensure release of 3,500 cusecs for 15 days

The Tamil Nadu government on Monday sought an early hearing of its application over the Cauvery water allocation dispute with neighbouring Karnataka.

Appearing for Tamil Nadu, senior advocate C.S. Vaidyanathan highlighted before Chief Justice of India (CJI) Surya Kant that the deficit in allocation of the river water has left farmers in a perilous situation. The CJI listed the State's application for hearing on Thursday.

to Karnataka to implement the July 30 decision of the Central Water Management Authority (CWMA) to ensure the release of 3500 cusecs for 15 days from its two reservoirs at Kabini and Krishna Raja Sagara. Tamil Nadu has ap-

proached the apex court for the release of 4.536 TMC (at the rate of 3500 cusecs for 15 days) on or before August 12.

The State urged the court to direct the CWMA to issue an appropriate direction to Karnataka to

make good, on a pro-rata basis, the shortfall at the inter-State point of Billigundulu for the period from June 1 to August 12, and in this regard release 26,954 TMC of water forthwith. It further sought an order to the CWMA to monitor the flows in the reservoirs of Karnataka every 10 days and ensure stipulated monthly/daily releases at Billigundulu.

The State claims that Karnataka had continued to defy the orders of the Cauvery tribunal for allocation of water to its neighbour except a few times when there were inevitable surpluses in the reservoirs on account of floods.

A fifth of Telangana voters face exclusion

More than a fifth of the electors throughout Telangana are likely to be deleted in the draft electoral rolls to be published at the end of the enumeration phase of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls in the State.

Around the same number of electors who submitted the form might receive notices from the office of the Electoral Registration Officers for verification.

The enumeration phase ended at midnight of August 10, after two extensions since July 24. Draft electoral rolls will be published after a week, on August 17. As at 6 p.m. on the final day, a total 73,47,075 enumeration forms have been categorised as Uncollectable, which, the Chief Electoral Officer C. Sudharshan Reddy has explained, are the forms not returned by the electors. They constitute close to 22% of the total State electorate.

A comprehensive sea rescue mechanism will be implemented in Kerala to ensure the safety of fishermen venturing into the sea, Chief Minister V.D. Satheesan said here on Monday.

He gave the assurance after visiting the residence of Gautam Krishnan, a 26-year-old fisher missing at sea since July 31 following a boat capsize off Neendakara. Gautam's father and

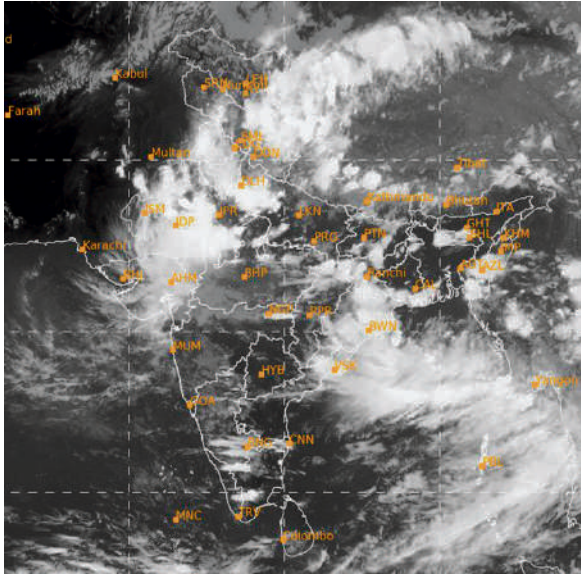
grandfather had lost their lives in the accident.

Mr. Satheesan, who was accompanied by Forest Minister Shibu Baby John, said search operations were continuing by integrating all available systems on an unprecedented scale, despite severe weather constraints.

He added that the State would develop a model weather forecasting framework for the entire country, noting that necessary funds had already been allocated in the Budget.
