Likha Asha, Advocate and also a JJB member delivered an awareness session on the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005, and sensitised participants about the legal safeguards and remedies available to women facing domestic violence.

Tawang prepares for proposed International Tourism Mart
