

Blaze at Jalandhar hospital: 20 pregnant women, newborns shifted to safety; no casualties

Jalandhar: A fire broke out in the gynaecology ward of the state-run Jalandhar Civil Hospital Tuesday morning but a major tragedy was averted as on-duty doctors swiftly shifted the occupants, including 20 pregnant women and newborns, to safety.

Sources said a short circuit might have caused fire that quickly spread through the ward around 6 am. "There is no loss of life. The timely intervention by the doctors, hospital staff and fire brigade helped avert what could have been a major tragedy," said Dr Priya Kaushal, Senior Medical Officer.

Kaushal said the fire caused extensive damage to the ward, with beds, mattresses, electrical equipment, the wiring and air-conditioning systems being gutted. She said resident doctors were present in the ward at the time of the fire outbreak and immediately alerted the hospital authorities. "The medical and paramedical teams began evacuating the pregnant women and newborns. The senior hospital team reached the spot within five minutes of receiving the information. The fire brigade personnel also reached the spot and brought the blaze under control," she said.

Firing at gurdwara in Uboke village, DSP says probe on

Amritsar: A FIRING incident was reported on the premises of a gurdwara during a religious event in Uboke village near Patti on Tuesday.

According to information, four persons allegedly suffered injuries in the firing, but no confirmation from police or the hospital where they are undergoing treatment has come yet.

DSP Ravisher Singh said, "Police are investigating the matter with utmost seriousness. A case is being registered, and appropriate legal action will be taken against both groups based on facts and evidence."

Speaking to reporters at the government hospital, Waris Punjab De leader Harpreet Singh Khalsa said, "Villagers invited me to attend a religious event. I was leaving the gurdwara after addressing the gathering with my supporters when Jagdeep Singh Jagga and his associates, who were waiting outside, opened fire at us." "Four of my supporters, Harjinder Singh, Narpinder Singh, Gursab Singh and Gurpreet Singh, suffered serious injuries in the attack, while several members of the congregation suffered pellet injuries," Khalsa claimed.

Jagdeep Singh or any representative of his faction could not be reached despite repeated efforts.

20.66 lakh voters in Punjab dropped from draft rolls

Among districts, highest deletion in Mohali with nearly 20% voters not returning enumeration forms

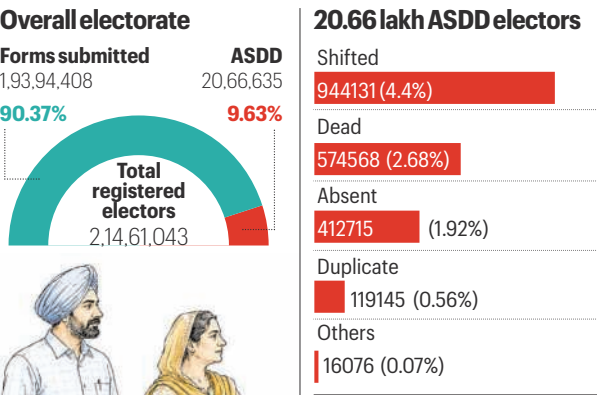
PUNJAB STARES at deletion of 20.66 lakh electors, accounting for 9.63 per cent of the total registered voters with the Election Commission categorising them as absent, shifted, dead, or duplicate (ASDD) after collecting and digitising the enumeration forms of nearly 1.94 crore electors as part of the ongoing Special Intensive Revision of electoral rolls.

Chief Electoral Officer Anindita Mitra said the house-to-house enumeration phase of the SIR exercise was carried out between June 25 and August 3. As of June 9, Punjab had 2,14,61,043 registered electors. Of these, 1,93,94,408 citizens submitted their enumeration forms by August 3, she said, adding there names will be included in the draft electoral roll-2026, which will be published on August 13. The remaining 20,66,635 electors have been categorised as ASDD, she said.

These include deaths: 5,74,568 (2.68 per cent of total electors), untraceable/absent: 4,12,715 (1.92 per cent), permanently shifted: 9,44,131 (4.40 per cent) and already enrolled: 1,19,145 (0.56 per cent), she said.

She said the house-to-house enumeration phase of the SIR 2026 has been completed across all 23 districts and 117 Assembly constituencies. It could be made possible with the dedicated efforts of 23 District Election Officers (DEOs), 117 Electoral Registration Officers (EROs), 234

Two ISI-backed cross-border terror modules busted, 4 minors among 9 held: Punjab Police

Express News Service Amritsar, Chandigarh, August 4

PUNJAB POLICE on Tuesday claimed to have busted two ISI-backed cross-border terror modules, apprehending nine accused, including four juveniles, with arms and ammunition.

"In a major breakthrough, Amritsar Commissionerate Police busts two ISI-backed cross-border terror modules, apprehends nine accused, including four juveniles, and recovers 311 legal pistols, 4 petrol bottle bombs, and 9 live cartridges," DGP Gaurav Yadav said in a post

on X. He said preliminary investigation revealed that the accused were acting at the behest of foreign-based ISI handlers, who were attempting to recruit local youth to carry out terror-related activities, conduct surveillance of security installations, procure illegal weapons and disturb public peace.

The investigation also uncovered the installation of surveillance cameras near railway tracks, with footage allegedly shared with foreign handlers, the DGP said.

FIRs have been registered at Mohkamura, airport and C-Division, Amritsar, police sta-

tions. Among those arrested are Vansh Kumar (19) and Anmol Singh alias Sahil (20) of Patti in Tarn Taran; Harman Singh alias Hammu (24), Sukhdev Singh (30) and Sukhman Singh (19) of Amritsar. The remaining four accused are juveniles, police said.

Apart from recovering pistols and petrol bottle bombs, police teams have also impounded one stolen motorcycle, which was being used by the accused for carrying out criminal activities, a Punjab Police statement said.

Further investigation is underway to identify the remaining members of the ISI-

assembly constituency category, Budhlada had highest collection at 96.94 per cent. SAS Nagar (Mohali) recorded the lowest voter participation at 82.01 per cent, as enumeration forms of nearly 1.54 lakh electors, out of a total electorate, were not returned.

Mitra said 93.40 per cent of the electors, to be included in the draft electoral roll, have been mapped with the electoral rolls of 2003 or previous SIR. She said beginning August 13, notices will be issued to un-mapped electors. The left-out voters should participate in the objections period between August 13 and September 12 to ensure their names are included in the final electoral roll.

As part of the SIR 2026, polling station rationalisation too was carried out to ensure greater accessibility and convenience for electors. The total number of polling stations has increased from 24,453 to 25,332 after rationalisation.

During the house-to-house enumeration exercise, the BLOs visited the all the registered electors to distribute enumeration forms.

Thereafter, they made at least three repeat visits to collect the filled forms. For electors unavailable during visits, information stickers were affixed at their residences to ensure that no eligible voter was left out in order to ensure that no genuine eligible elector is left out of the draft electoral roll.

A month-long SVEEP (Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation) plan was implemented using multi-channel outreach.

To further ensure maximum outreach to genuine electors, special camps were also organised across all 117 Assembly constituencies at polling booths on June 7, July 11-12 and July 19. These camps provided additional opportunities for electors to submit their forms and verify their details.
