

Annamalalai floats new ‘political movement’, to fight next T.N. polls

Former Tamil Nadu BJP chief K. Annamalalai, who quit the party earlier this week, on Friday announced the launch of a “political movement”, inspired by the ideals promoted by former President A.P.J. Abdul Kalam.

A few hours before his announcement, the BJP said its national president Nitin Nabin had accepted Mr. Annamalalai’s resignation from the primary membership of the BJP.

Sharing his idea of the new political movement on social media platforms, Mr. Annamalalai said it would eventually become a political party. All its functionaries would be trained at Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Centre for Ethics and Politics in Coimbatore before they face any election, he said.

Resignations follow

After Mr. Annamalalai’s announcement, several BJP functionaries, including State unit vice-president Karu. Nagarajan, resigned from the party, and said they would join him. Many BJP functionaries took to the social media expressing their support for the new movement.

Mr. Annamalalai said there were several “issues” in the BJP, which were flagged to the national leadership “patiently” over several months before his resignation. Though he conveyed his decision to part ways with the BJP on December 4 last year, he

said he accepted the party’s request and stayed on until the completion of the Tamil Nadu Assembly election in May 2026.

The former IPS officer said he continued to respect Prime Minister Narendra Modi but chose to disagree with him on certain issues with courage. He chose to meet BJP leader and Union Minister Amit Shah to convey his decision “eye to eye”. He maintained that he had “no animosity against the BJP”.

Even as he sought time from his supporters for his movement to evolve into a political party, he said there is “no doubt that it will face the next general election” in Tamil Nadu. He said the new initiative would accommodate the views of Gen Z, Gen Alpha as well as the elderly.

Mr. Annamalalai said there was indeed space for a new party in Tamil Nadu. “We will have to come out of cult politics. This will be common man’s politics, there will be no compromise on principles,” he said. He stressed the need for a “term limit” for elected representatives. “There cannot be permanent MPs, MLAs, or Ministers.”

Denied ‘promised’ portfolio, Karnataka Minister resigns

Eight-time MLA Ramalinga Reddy says he was promised Bengaluru development portfolio but was given irrigation projects; however, he adds that he will not leave Congress; CM set to meet him

The two-day-old Congress government in Karnataka, led by Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar, suffered a setback on Friday when Minister Ramalinga Reddy resigned, expressing displeasure over portfolio allocation.

Mr. Reddy said he was promised the Bengaluru Development portfolio but was instead made Minister for Major and Medium Irrigation Projects.

The resignation came after Mr. Shivakumar allotted portfolios on Thursday night. “I am resigning from my post because I cannot work against conscience,” Mr. Reddy said at a press conference. “How long can

I tolerate this humiliation? Twice they called me and promised to give me that (Bengaluru Development) portfolio, but in the end it went to someone else. That is why I feel hurt,” Mr. Reddy told reporters, while asserting that he would continue in the Congress and remain an MLA.

The development marks the first major challenge for the Shivakumar government, which assumed office on Wednesday.

Mr. Reddy, an eight-time MLA from Bengaluru, said he had never lobbied for a ministerial office or sought any specific department during his five-decade-long

political career.

Asked whether he would reconsider his decision if persuaded by the party leadership or offered the portfolio he wanted, Mr. Reddy replied with a firm “no”.

Sources close to Mr. Shivakumar said that his resignation had not yet been accepted. The Chief Minister said he would meet Mr. Reddy personally to pacify him. The Chief Minister acknowledged that he had earlier assured Mr. Reddy of the Bengaluru Development portfolio, but said the final decision rested with the party leadership.

The development coincides with the upcoming municipal elections in Bengaluru, a constituency where Mr. Reddy holds considerable sway.

13 Karnataka Ministers face criminal cases

Of the 14 Ministers in the reconstituted Karnataka State Cabinet, 13 are corepatris with their average assets around ₹206.15 crore, according to an analysis by the Association for Democratic Reforms (ADR).

A corepati is one who has total assets worth at least ₹1 crore. The Karnataka State Cabinet was reconstituted on

Wednesday. The ADR and the Karnataka Election Watch – both NGOs – have analysed the self-sworn affidavits of 13 of the 14 Ministers.

The records of one Minister, Kelachandra Joseph George, from the Sarvananagar constituency was not analysed due to the unavailability of clear and complete affidavits on the Election Commission’s website.

According to the report,

all 13 (100%) Ministers have declared criminal cases against themselves. Three Ministers (23% of the Cabinet) have declared serious criminal cases against themselves.

CM tops assets’ list

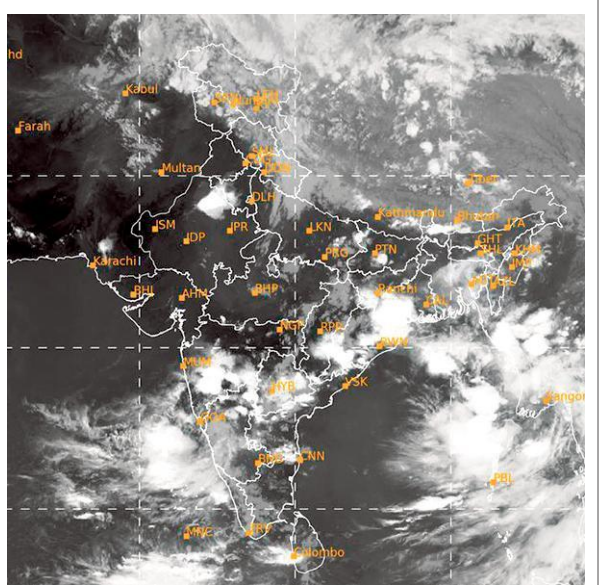
The Minister with the highest declared total assets was Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar from the Kana-kapura constituency with assets worth ₹1,413.80 crore, while U.T. Khader

Fared from the Mangalore constituency had the lowest declared total assets of ₹6.97 crore. All 13 (100%) Ministers have declared liabilities, with Mr. Shivakumar topping the list with liabilities of ₹265.06 crore.

Three (23%) Ministers have declared their educational qualification to be between 10th and 12th standard, while 10 (77%) Ministers have declared an educational qualification of graduation or above.
