Yogi plays SP for changing colours

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath said, "Girgit ki tarah badalne wali party ke log PDA ko kaise paribhashit karthe hain. Kabhi inka 'P' Pichhda tha, phir Pandit ho gaya. Dekhna, ek din ye log 'P' se Pakistan kar denge". He pointed out that the Samajwadi Party's statements cannot be trusted, and no one can predict what they will say next. They are like vultures that dry up the very tree they perch on. CM further remarked, "Those distressing things that were while Mayawati came and paid tribute to Babuji as a matter of courtesy and values, the SP chief neither came personally to pay homage nor expressed even a few words in his memory. It was extremely unfortunate and shameful. It was an insult to every Hindu who believes that Babuji dedicated his life to Sanatan values and Hindu pride."

Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath attended the 'Gaurav Diwas' programme organised on Friday at Bharat Ratna Atal Bihari Vajpayee Ekana Cricket Stadium on the fifth death anniversary of former Chief Minister and Padma

Vibhushan Kalyan Singh. He paid floral tribute to the portrait of former CM and former Governor of Rajasthan and Himachal Pradesh, Padma Vibhushan Kalyan Singh 'Babuji'. Referring to the Shri Ram Janmabhoomi movement, the CM said, "Babuji was never a person who worked under pressure. He (Kalyan Singh) often said: 'Kalyan Singh may break, but he cannot bend.'"

Yogi further stated, "Babuji upheld this principle throughout his life. During the Ram Janmabhoomi movement, he had clearly stated that the struggle was acceptable, losing power was acceptable, but insulting Lord Shri Ram was not. Today, when people see the grand Ram Temple in Ayodhya and Ram Lalla enshrined there, Babuji's memory naturally comes to mind. He openly supported the Ram Janmabhoomi movement led by saints under the guidance of the Rashtriya Swamsevaks and the leadership of the Vishva Hindu Parishad. He lost power but firmly declared that bullets would not be fired on Ram devotees."

The Chief Minister highlighted, "Babuji dedicated his life to values, and that became his identity. The SP

leadership did not merely insist Babuji at the time of his passing; disrespecting great figures is a habit of theirs."

He added, "Although Kannauj has long been associated with the Samajwadi Party, the SP leadership removed Dr Bhimrao Ambedkar's name from the government medical college established there. The BJP government restored Babasaheb's name. Similarly, the SP government removed

Lokmata Ahilyabai Holkar's name from a college in Mainpuri. The BJP government later established a new medical college in Auraiya in the name of Lokmata Ahilyabai Holkar."

The CM remarked that Kalyan Singh's life remains a source of inspiration for every Indian who believes the nation comes first and that India's Sanatan values and ideals are paramount. He said the day is an occasion for

all of us to observe Hindu Gaurav Diwas and draw inspiration from the memories and life of Babuji. The CM said, "Babuji's life was marked by simplicity, discipline, devotion, and struggle. He fought against injustice and oppression and devoted his entire life to protecting Sanatan values and serving the poor of the villages, the food-provider farmers, the youth, and every section of society."

Focus on public issues: Maya to Centre, states

BSP supremo Mayawati on Friday said the political debate over whether the complete version of Vande Mataram should be sung or not was "not right", urging governments at the Centre and states to focus on issues of public interest, particularly unemployment among youth.

In a post on X, Mayawati said the law recently passed by Parliament concerning the singing of Vande Mataram was not the first instance of such a change. She said whenever there is a change of government at the Centre or in states, political parties keep changing laws made by their predecessors according to their political interests or to divert public attention from their shortcomings.

"The ongoing politics in the country right now regarding whether to sing the full 'Vande Mataram', or just the first two stanzas (paragraphs), or not to sing it at all-this is not right," the

former Uttar Pradesh chief minister said.

Mayawati said governments at the Centre and in the states, as well as all political parties, should instead focus on issues of public interest, particularly unemployment among youth and concerns of students and Gen-A Alpha.

She also highlighted the severe floods in some parts of the country and the resulting loss of life and property, saying there were several other important issues that required immediate attention. "This is the most pressing need of the hour in the interest of the country and the people," she said. Her remarks came after a war of words broke out between the BJP and the Congress over the singing of full version of Vande Mataram.

The BJP has slammed the Congress, alleging that its decision to sing just two stanzas of Vande Mataram, "anti-national" and aimed at appeasing its vote bank in defiance of the law.

54 suspected ivory artefacts seized

In a joint operation by the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI), Lucknow, and the Uttar Pradesh Forest Department, authorities recovered 54 suspected wildlife artefacts that appeared to be made of ivory. They arrested four people in connection with the matter late on August 19.

After DRI handed over the seized material and the four persons to the Forest Department, the Forest Department team immediately initiated further legal action, given the seriousness of the case and the possible involvement of wildlife articles of protected species.

"The 54 suspected artefacts were formally taken into the safe custody of the Forest Department. Officials took necessary measures to preserve the material and maintain the integrity of the evidence. The seized articles were duly secured and sealed as per procedure," said DFO Awadh Sitanshu Pandey. On preliminary examination, the recovered articles appeared to be made of ivory, raising suspicion of a possible link to an offence involving wildlife derivatives. The Forest Department initiated legal proceedings under the relevant provisions of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, and arrested all four persons.
