

HC lawyers
step in to pay
MVD fine on
flood-rescue
vehicle

Days after the Motor Vehicles department (MVD) issued a fresh notice revising the fine on a modified off-road vehicle used in flood-rescue operations at Aranmula to ₹50,000, a collective of lawyers in the Kerala High Court on Monday handed over the amount to its owner for paying the fine.

The penalty was revised after the Kerala High Court examined the Transport Commissioner's report on the vehicle and found six additional lights and tyres projecting laterally beyond the vehicle's body.

Advocate Arun S. Nair handed over the money to Amal Vidwan of Kulanada at the office of Aranmula MLA Abin Varkey. Speaking on the occasion, Mr. Varkey reiterated his criticism of the MVD, calling its decision to penalise a vehicle engaged in flood-rescue operations inappropriate and insensitive to the circumstances.

Family gatherings have begun in Kozhikode district ahead of the three-day extended State committee meeting of the Communist Party of India (Marxist) [CPI(M)], scheduled to be held in Kozhikode city from September 13.

The main agenda of the meeting, which is expected to have all the features of a State conference, according to sources, is to discuss the debacle of the Left Democratic Front and the CPI(M) in the recent Assembly elections and devise ways to rejuvenate the cadre. Deliberations on the

issue have already been completed at all levels of the party, from the branch level to the State committee.

A review report brought

out recently by the Central Committee, based on a report approved by the State committee, says that "party committee members at all levels were asked to

speak freely and frankly, while the leaders from the higher committee heard their opinions without commenting."

The sources say that State committee members from various districts and district secretariat members are now summing up the party's final analysis of the results at the gatherings.

Held under the aegis of the party's 270 local committees in the district, the gatherings began on September 5 and will conclude on September 10. Members from families that are fellow travellers or sympathisers of the CPI(M) are attending them. Senior party leaders are being ho-

noured, and cultural events are also being held.

Mass contact

Meanwhile, participants at the State committee meeting are expected to discuss ways to strengthen mass contact and improve the functioning of the party and its mass organisations. The agenda is also expected to include the mode of agitations against the Union government and its policies.

The CPI(M) has also announced plans to hold a massive rally featuring over one lakh people at Kozhikode beach to mark the culmination of the State committee meeting on September 15.

Karuvatta murder: police get custody of three minors

The Alappuzha Juvenile Justice Board on Monday permitted the police to take three minors accused in the Karuvatta murder case into custody for evidence collection.

Considering a petition in this regard, the board rejected the argument that the Juvenile Justice (Care

and Protection of Children) Act does not permit such custody and allowed the police to take the three boys into custody in connection with the investigation.

The order is expected to aid the investigation into the murder of a senior citizen who was found dead at his rented house in Karuvatta near Haripad on August 16. Four minors, in-

cluding the victim's 13-year-old granddaughter, are accused in the case. The three boys, aged between 16 and 17, are suspected of carrying out the murder.

The prosecution argued that while Section 10 of the Juvenile Justice Act prohibits placing a child in a police lock-up or jail, the provision does not bar the Juvenile Justice Board from

permitting custody for the purpose of collecting evidence. It sought custody under the applicable criminal procedure provisions, submitting that investigators needed to recover material evidence and establish the sequence of events.

The prosecution also pointed out that the case had no eyewitnesses and that the alleged murder

took place inside a locked house at night, with minors being the only accused. Taking the accused to relevant locations for evidence collection was therefore necessary to prevent the investigation from being hampered, it submitted.

The latest order follows an earlier attempt by the police to question the three boys.

Exclude inhabited areas from ESA, says Orthodox Church

The Malankara Orthodox church on Monday urged the State government to address the concerns of residents of the high-range areas of Pathanamthitta district regarding the seventh draft notification on ecologically sensitive areas (ESA) in the Western Ghats.

In a statement, Malankara Association secretary Biju Oommen said the government should intervene to ensure that in-

habited areas and agricultural land were excluded from the ESA and that its limits were confined to forest areas. He also called for a balanced approach that protected the environment without compromising the livelihood security of high-range communities.

He also sought the exclusion of farms, plantations, places of worship, educational institutions, hospitals and commercial establishments from the final notification. Public hearings should be held in affected areas..., he said.
