

UP monsoon activity picks up, red alert issued for multiple districts

37 UP districts still face rain deficit, 29 districts experience normal rainfall, and only nine districts record excess to large excess rain

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LUCKNOW: With heavy rainfall forecast to persist across Uttar Pradesh, the India meteorological department (IMD) has placed multiple districts under red, orange, and yellow alerts. This spell of weather follows a welcome boost in monsoon activity, which has successfully pulled the state's seasonal rain deficit into the 'normal' category at 17% as of Tuesday morning. Alongside this, IMD also predicted scattered heavy rainfall across the state through August 23.

According to IMD, the western end of the monsoon trough has shifted north of its normal position towards the Himalayan foothills, running from Shahjahanpur and Varanasi through concentrated low-pressure areas in Jharkhand and on to the North-East Bay of Bengal via Digha. This has resulted in active conditions across the state for the next two days.

Subsequently, the IMD has issued a red alert for Wednesday, indicating a high probability of heavy rainfall in nine districts: Banda, Chitrakoot, Kaushambi, Prayagraj, Sonbhadra, Mirzapur, Chandauli, Sant Ravidas Nagar, Mahoba and surrounding areas.

An orange alert has been issued for Fatehpur, Pratapgarh, Varanasi, Jaunpur, Hamirpur, Lalitpur and surrounding areas, signalling a high probability of heavy rainfall. A yellow alert for heavy rainfall has been issued for 11 districts: Ghazipur, Azamgarh, Kannauj, Kanpur Dehat, Kanpur Nagar, Unnao, Rae Bareilly, Amethi, Sultanpur,

Waterlogging: High court hauls up Prayagraj civic bosses

PRAYAGRAJ: The Allahabad high court on Tuesday took suo motu cognisance of the severe waterlogging in Prayagraj, as a result of a heavy downpour, noting that the civic failure has caused delay in judges reaching court.

The court has directed the DM and the municipal commissioner of Prayagraj to appear in court and explain "why measures were not taken in advance to ensure that the city, particularly the low-lying areas, do not get waterlogged" during the rainy season.

The bench comprising justice Ajit Kumar and justice Garima Prashad initiated suo moto proceedings after the city got "waterlogged due to incessant rain", causing difficulties to judges in reaching court.

The court has also asked the secretary of urban development and planning to file a personal affidavit by August 20, clarifying the plans approved for ensuring that the city does not get waterlogged.

Auraiya, Jalaun, Jhansi and their surrounding regions. UP's seasonal rainfall has improved, dragging the state's overall deficit into the "normal" category. The deficit plummeted from 22% on Sunday to 17% by Tuesday morning, according to data from the Regional Meteorological Centre, Lucknow.

In the last 24 hours, the average rainfall recorded across the state was 19.5 mm. Bijnor

recorded the heaviest rainfall at 118.6 mm, followed by Sambhal (102.2 mm), Prayagraj (73.4 mm) and Moradabad (66.6 mm).

Seven meteorological observatories in UP recorded extremely heavy rainfall in the last 24 hours: Meja (Prayagraj) received 192 mm; Dhampur (Bijnor), 162 mm; Gunnaur (Sambhal), 150 mm; Koraoan (Prayagraj), 126 mm; Ghorawal (Sonbhadra), 123 mm; Bijnor, 146 mm; and Nagina

Rivers in spate flood 173 villages

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LUCKNOW: A rise in the water level of various rivers has flooded 173 villages in 13 districts of UP, affecting 84,362 people and inundating 13,058 hectares of agricultural land, according to the UP relief commissioner office's data.

The flood-affected districts include Badaun, Bahraich, Ballia, Barabanki, Bijnor, Farrukhabad, Gautam Buddh Nagar, Gonda, Kasganj, Lakhimpur Kheri, Muzaffarnagar, Sitapur and Unnao.

The Ghaghra was flowing above the danger mark near the Elgin Bridge in Barabanki. The Ganga was flowing near the danger mark in Badaun and Farrukhabad districts.

The Sharda was at the danger mark in Lakhimpur Kheri, while the Ghaghra was flowing near it in Shravasti, Ayodhya and Ballia. An alert has been sounded after an increase in the water level of the rivers in Garhmukteshwar, Badaun, Farrukhabad, Kanpur Nagar, Barabanki, Ayodhya, Ballia and Kushinagar districts.

Relief commissioner, UP, Hrishikesh Bhaskar Yashod on Tuesday conducted a detailed review of relief and rescue operations being carried out in the flood-affected areas of the state.

He directed the DMs to evacuate people living in flood-affected areas to flood relief camps or other safer places as needed and ensure the availability of food, medical care and essential relief materials to affected families.

All flood spots should be kept fully operational and water level of rivers and flood situation should be continuously monitored. The safety of people and property should be given top priority by ensuring adequate boats, motorboats, rescue teams and other necessary resources in the flood-affected areas, Yashod said.

SHOWERS TEST ₹463-CR DRAINAGE PLAN AS WATERLOGGING REIGNS

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LUCKNOW: The state capital's battle against urban flooding faced another test on Tuesday, with heavy rain leaving roads and neighbourhoods waterlogged despite a ₹463-crore drainage and flood-management push announced by the civic body just two months ago.

Waterlogging was reported from Jankipuram, Faizullaganj, Ashiana sectors 1, J and M, Mawaiyya, Alambagh and Gomti Nagar Extension. Several localities, including Jopling Road, Mahanagar, Indira Nagar Sector C and Gokhale Marg, also witnessed water accumulation.

Traffic was disrupted on key stretches around Charbagh, Hussainganj, Vidhan Bhavan and Alambagh Bus Station.

Congress corporator Mukesh Singh Chauhan said the LMC had announced an overall drainage and urban flood-management push of around ₹463 crore in June, including new and upgraded drains, expansion of the storm-water network and additional pumping infrastructure. "Of this, ₹300 crore was earmarked under the Urban Flood and Storm Water Scheme for vulnerable areas," he said.

Another ₹58.15 crore was allocated for construction and improvement of 63 drains. As of the June review, 36 drains had reportedly been completed and work on the remaining projects was underway.

The civic body has also planned to strengthen pumping infrastructure. Nearly ₹10 crore has been spent or earmarked for the work, including a new pumping station near the zoo and a pump at Mallahi Tola.

Seven more pumping stations, estimated to cost around ₹56 crore, had been approved, with tenders under process during the June assessment. The LMC's 2026-27 budget also provides ₹15 crore for drain cleaning and ₹5 crore for operation and maintenance of flood-pumping stations.

Municipal commissioner Gaurav Kumar said the civic body was working to increase the water-carrying capacity of drains, improve their connectivity with the wider storm-water network, remove encroachments and silt, address outfalls and ensure timely pumping. "Water receded in most areas within an hour," attributing this to steps taken by the LMC, Kumar said.

JeM-linked arrest: ATS to probe terror funding trail, Pak contacts

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LUCKNOW: The Uttar Pradesh Anti-Terrorist Squad (ATS) is likely to widen its investigation into the alleged Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM) links of a 24-year-old Bihar resident by tracing the flow of funds, identifying his Pakistan-based handlers and examining whether he was part of a larger terror-funding and radicalisation network, senior ATS officials said on Tuesday.

Mohammad Zafar, a resident of Purnia district in Bihar, was arrested from Meerut by the UP ATS on Sunday. According to a press note issued by the agency, Zafar allegedly collected donations in the name of a madrasa and attempted to send money to Pakistan-based handlers for activities linked to jihad in India.

The ATS alleged that Zafar established contact with suspected Pakistani operatives and transferred money several times in the form of USDT through Binance. Investigators are now expected to reconstruct the financial trail, from the source of the donations and identities of

contributors to the digital wallets and accounts through which the money was allegedly routed.

A senior ATS official said the cryptocurrency transactions are likely to form a key component of the investigation. The ATS may examine Zafar's Binance account and associated wallet addresses to determine the ultimate beneficiaries. Investigators are also likely to scrutinise an alleged failed attempt to transfer money to a Pakistan bank.

He said the agency is likely to identify and question the Pakistan-based contacts found on Zafar's phone. The ATS official said several Pakistan-based jihadist WhatsApp groups were found on his device and alleged that he came into contact with a Pakistani handler after joining a JeM-related jihadist group.

Investigators are likely to examine the digital trail to establish how Zafar was recruited, who directed him and whether he was acting independently or under instructions from handlers operating from Pakistan. His social media activity and electronic devices will also be scrutinised.

UNNAO GANGA EXPRESSWAY STRETCH REPAIRED: ROAD OPERATOR

KANPUR: A section of the Ganga Expressway damaged after heavy rain in Unnao on Monday has been repaired, with the road operator saying there were no issues at the affected stretch on Tuesday.

Adani road transport, which maintains the expressway, said teams were sent to km 421 in Dahi, Unnao, after the damage was reported. Project manager RK Mishra said repairs were

completed without affecting traffic and the expressway remained open throughout. "We are keeping a close watch on stretches that could be affected by rain," Mishra said.

The 594-km Ganga Expressway connects Meerut with Prayagraj and passes through 12 districts of Uttar Pradesh. It has faced scrutiny after rain-related damage was reported on parts of the road.

AISA's 'Gen Z Mahajutan Yatra' from September 9

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LUCKNOW: The All India Students' Association (AISA) on Tuesday announced the 'GEN-Z Mahajutan Yatra' across Uttar Pradesh as part of its 'GenZ Rising' campaign to unite students and youth around issues of education reforms, entrance exam policies, and unemployment.

The proposed yatra will start

from Prayagraj on September 9, followed by Rae Bareilly on September 10, Varanasi on September 12, Azamgarh on September 13, Gorakhpur on September 14, Lucknow on September 17 and Meerut on September 18.

Addressing a press conference at the UP Press Club here, AISA leaders said the yatra will be led by their president Neha and state chief Manish. Jawaharlal Nehru University Students' Union (JNUSU) president Aditi and joint secretary Danish will also join the yatra at select locations, they added.

On June 12, students gathered at Eco Garden in Lucknow against paper leaks and exam irregularities. On July 25, similar protests erupted in Prayagraj, Lucknow, Jhansi, Saharanpur and other districts with demands for fair exams and accountability, Manish said.

"The GEN-Z Mahajutan Yatra is an attempt to carry the Jantar Mantar momentum forward across UP," said AISA secretary Prasenjit Kumar.
