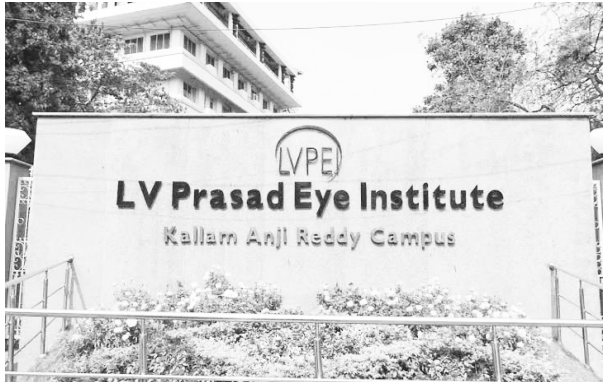


BostonSight, LVPEI being clinical trial to study mental health impact of specialty lenses



Hyderabad, Aug 10 (UNI)

BostonSight and L V Prasad Eye Institute (LVPEI) have initiated a prospective clinical trial to evaluate the impact of PROSE and SCLERAL specialty lenses on the mental health of patients with corneal and ocular surface diseases. The Institutional Re-

view Board (IRB)-approved, multi-site study will involve new PROSE patients referred to LVPEI from across India and beyond. The trial is part of BostonSight’s ongoing research into the efficacy of specialty lenses and their impact on patients’ quality of life, expanding earlier research

focused on the cornea and ocular surface, the Institute said in a release here on Monday. The study will assess whether specialty lens treatment is associated with measurable improvements in mental health. Researchers will use the Patient Health Questionnaire-9 (PHQ-9) to measure mental health outcomes, the Ocular Surface Disease Index (OSDI) to assess ocular surface symptoms and the Visual Function Questionnaire-25 (VFQ-25) to evaluate visual functioning. The primary objective is to identify a direct correlation between quantifiable mental health outcomes and specialty lens treatment, while examining how changes in mental health relate to scores on vision- and ocular surface-related questionnaires. The researchers said

the study could help raise awareness of mental health challenges associated with ocular surface disease and encourage earlier interventions using PROSE and other specialty lenses. “IRB approval is an important milestone that confirms the study meets established ethical and regulatory standards. We are excited to move forward with this important study to evaluate quantifiable mental health outcomes associated with these specialty lenses,” said Dr Prashant Garg, Executive Chair, LVPEI. BostonSight Chief Medical Officer Dr Daniel Brooks said mental health was often overlooked in the care of patients with ocular surface disease. He said improvements in vision, ocular comfort and ocular health could have a signifi-

cant effect on mental health, adding that the study would seek to objectively measure the impact. LVPEI has been a long-term partner of BostonSight and distributes PROSE and SCLERAL lenses in India and the surrounding region. The custom, non-surgical medical lenses are designed to provide comfort and visual clarity for people with corneal and ocular surface diseases. BostonSight said PROSE and SCLERAL are FDA-cleared medical devices used as part of customised medical treatment. BostonSight SCLERAL is commercially available for mild to moderate corneal and ocular surface disease conditions.

NALSAR students urge varsity to reconsider CJI as Convocation guest

Students of NALSAR University of Law have urged the varsity administration to reconsider inviting Chief Justice of India Surya Kant as the chief guest for its upcoming convocation, citing concerns over his reported remarks during proceedings on a petition relating to alleged police action against protesters. Students from different batches, including the outgoing 2026 LLB and

LLM batches, reportedly sent an email to the Vice-Chancellor, Registrar and professors on July 23, requesting the university not to invite the CJI. The students said their objection stemmed from a Supreme Court Bench headed by the CJI reportedly declining urgent listing of a plea concerning alleged police action against protesters during a ‘Chalo Sansad’ demonstration at Jantar Mantar on July 20. They also referred to reported remarks by

the CJI that the Bench was not interested in watching videos when the lead counsel offered to show footage of the alleged police action. “As students of law, our concern is narrower and more specific to us as a graduating batch,” the students said, arguing that a convocation should reflect NALSAR’s values of constitutional rights, access to justice and reasoned engagement with grievances. They said receiving their degrees from a dignitary whose recent public conduct, as reported, appeared dismissive of allegations of police brutality against protesters would be at odds with the values taught at the law university. The students also said the protesters had raised concerns relating to the NEET examination and reforms in the National Testing Agency. Around 450 students have backed the representation, accounting for nearly one-third of NALSAR’s approximately 1,400-strong student body.

Retired Army man killed, two injured in hit-and-run in Hyderabad

A retired Army man was killed and two others seriously injured in a hit-and-run accident at Hydershah Kote in Gandipet, on the outskirts of the city, on Sunday night, police said. The accident occurred near SMP School when a speeding Mahindra SUV 350 allegedly rammed into the retired Army personnel while he was walking along the road. The former army man killed on the spot. The SUV then allegedly hit

two persons travelling on a bike-taxi. Both sustained serious injuries and were shifted to a private hospital for treatment. After the incident, the young men travelling in the SUV abandoned the vehicle at the spot and fled. Narsingi Police traced the vehicle through its registration number and found that it was registered in Shamshabad. Police reached the spot, registered a case and launched an investigation to identify and apprehend those responsible.
