Prithish Panda, the nodal officer appointed by the state government to assist people from Odisha stranded in Nepal, said the couple's last GPS location was traced near the immigration counter at Tumire, in the Nepal-Tibet border. The tour guide accompanying the couple is also untraceable.

Panda also said that six students from Bhubaneswar who travelled to Nepal to participate in a football match are in Pokhara along with their coach. Efforts are being made to facilitate their return, he added. A three-member group from Puri that was in Nepal has also been accounted for. "Also, Rakesh Kumar Panda of Puri safely crossed into India through the Raxaul check post," Panda said.



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According to preliminary in-

formation, the group had travelled in three vehicles from Landruk to Rasuwa. One of the vehicles was caught in a sudden flash flood near the Boteokoshi Rivert. Twenty Tamil pilgrims travelling in the vehicle were evacuated immediately. They were taken to a safe location associated with the Armed Police Force in the Timure area, where they are staying. Raj Mohan said the government was closely monitoring the whereabouts and safety of the pilgrims. He said information was trickling in because of difficult weather conditions.

The arrangement came to light after neighbours grew suspicious when they noticed that the baby was not with Pav

thra after she returned home. They alerted the authorities, following which the matter was brought to the notice of the Villivakkam police.

Police have invoked Sections 80 and 81 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act and Sections 9 and 61 of BNS against the accused. Police said two more people could be arrested as the investigation progresses.
