Gestamp expands India footprint with INR 523.7 crore

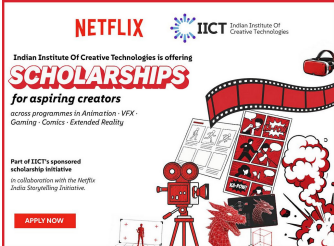
