

Radhakrishnan took Indian intellectual tradition to global stage: Prof Chaturvedi

SHIMLA, SEPTEMBER 5 Professor Himanshu Kumar Chaturvedi, Director, Indian Institute of Advanced Study (IIAS), today paid tribute to Dr Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, saying that the great teacher, philosopher and educationist played an important role in placing the Indian intellectual tradition on the global stage.

Delivering the presidential address at a Teachers' Day celebration, he said Radhakrishnan's life represented an outstanding synthesis of Indian education, philosophy and the pursuit of knowledge. Highlighting Radhakrishnan's association with the establishment of the IIAS, Prof Chaturvedi said Teachers' Day was significant for the institute not merely as an important national observance, but also as an occasion linked to its intellectual heritage and the memory of its Founder-President.

He further emphasised the importance of independent

thinking, dialogue and the continuous pursuit of knowledge in higher education and advanced study.

"This Day holds particular significance for the IIAS as both Teachers' Day and the intellectual heritage of the institute are closely connected with the personality and

legacy of Dr Radhakrishnan. The ideals established by him in education, philosophy and advanced study continue to inspire independent and deeper intellectual discourse," he said.

Professor S Ranganath, fellow, IIAS, while referring to the life and personality of

Dr Radhakrishnan, highlighted his philosophical thought, dedication to education and efforts to connect the Indian knowledge tradition with global intellectual discourse. He said Radhakrishnan's life exemplified how the role of a teacher could extend far beyond the

confines of the classroom to contribute to the intellectual development of society and the nation.

Professor Brijendra Pandey, fellow, IIAS, who delivered a special lecture, highlighted the historical and intellectual significance of Teachers' Day and recalled Dr Radhakrishnan's contribution. Referring to Radhakrishnan's philosophical outlook and ideas on education, he emphasised the need to connect knowledge with life and society. Recalling Dr Radhakrishnan's role as Founder-President of the IIAS, he said the purpose of advanced study extended beyond academic specialisation to encourage independent thought, dialogue and wider human concerns.

Earlier, floral tributes were offered by those present to Dr Radhakrishnan's portrait. The programme was attended by National Fellows, Tagore Fellows, Fellows, IUC Associates, Section Heads and other members of the institute.

Addressing the gathering, Pathania said Himachal Pradesh had improved its position in education from 21st to fifth in the country under the leadership of Chief Minister Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu.

He said the introduction of five new courses at Shahpur College would give students in the region access to vocational and job-oriented education close to their homes. The courses would also create new employment opportunities for students pursuing higher education.

Pathania said the state gov-

ernment had taken a historic decision to appoint professors and assistant professors in universities through the Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission to curb irregularities. He added that discussions were under way with a reputed institution to provide online coaching for competitive examinations to students of Classes VIII to X. Pathania congratulated teachers on Teachers' Day and lauded their contribution to education. He honoured teachers from the Shahpur area for their outstanding work in the field.

UNA, SEPTEMBER 5 Deputy Chief Minister Mukesh Agnihotri today presided over the closing ceremony of the 41st Zonal School Under-14 (Boys) Sports Tournament at Government Senior Secondary School, Kangar, in Haroli subdivision. Around 350 students from 35 schools of the subdivision took part in the three-day tournament. They competed in volleyball, kho-kho, kabaddi, chess, wrestling and badminton.

Earlier, Agnihotri inaugurated a digital library on the school campus, built at a cost

of Rs 13.75 lakh. Speaking on the occasion, he announced that music classes would be started at the school from the next academic session. He also announced the construction of an additional building on the campus, which will have four rooms, a solar power plant and a water drainage system.

The Deputy CM said an additional building would be inaugurated at Prof Simmi Agnihotri Government College, Haroli, to provide better educational facilities to students of the Assembly segment. He said efforts were also under way to start MSc, Law and Music degree courses

at the college from the next academic session.

Agnihotri said a 'Holi Fest' would be organised at the Kangar village ground during the coming Holi festival to promote cultural activities in the region. He asked Panchayat Pradhan Vinod Kumar 'Bittu' to formulate plans for organising the festival. He also announced a grant of Rs 5 lakh each for the strengthening and construction of link roads in wards 2 and 5 of Kangar panchayat. The Deputy CM gave away prizes and trophies to the winning teams of the Under-14 Zonal School Sports Tournament.

Teachers can build a self-reliant Viksit Bharat, says CUHP VC

DHARAMSALA, SEPTEMBER 5 Teachers are not merely transmitters of knowledge but also mentors, researchers, innovators and nation-builders who can drive social transformation, said Prof (Dr) SP Bansal, Vice-Chancellor of Central University of Himachal Pradesh (CUHP), Dharamsala, in his Teachers' Day message on Saturday.

Extending greetings to teachers, research scholars, students, officers and non-teaching staff, Prof Bansal called upon the university community to work together to build a self-reliant, innovative, inclusive and globally relevant institution.

Reflecting on the changing educational landscape, he said artificial intelligence, technological disruption, climate change and evolving socio-economic realities had made the role of teachers more important than ever. "Artificial intelligence may provide an answer, but a teacher helps a student ask the right question," he said, stressing that technology should remain a tool for human development and should not replace human values, empathy and judgement.

Prof Bansal said a self-reliant university should have the capacity to generate knowledge, innovations, partnerships and resources while

remaining connected with society. He urged faculty members to strengthen research, entrepreneurship, consultancy, technology transfer and interdisciplinary collaboration, ensuring that research translated into solutions for real-life challenges.

Highlighting CUHP's location in the Himalayan region, he said the university had an opportunity to emerge as a national centre of excellence in Himalayan ecology, disaster resilience, climate change, biodiversity, sustainable tourism, indigenous knowledge, mountain agriculture and community development.

"The Himalayas are not merely our geographical location; they can become our academic laboratory, our research inspiration and our contribution to the nation," he said.

Describing CUHP as a fam-

ily, Prof Bansal said institutional excellence depended on the collective contribution of teachers, students, researchers, administrative and technical staff and other employees. Through community engagement and initiatives such as Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, he said, students should help solve problems faced by villages and mountain communities. Linking education with the vision of Viksit Bharat@2047, Prof. Bansal said universities must nurture young people with professional competence, integrity, creativity, scientific temper and a spirit of service. He called for a shift from research output to research impact, from employment seekers to opportunity creators, and from institutional dependence to self-reliance.

NIT to host three-day Shiksha Mahakumbh

The National Institute of Technology (NIT), Hamirpur, will host the three-day 'Shiksha Mahakumbh Edition 6' from October 9. NIT Director Prof HM Suryavanshi stated this while addressing the media at the institute today. The NIT will organise Shiksha Mahakumbh in collaboration with the DHE unit of VBTR, IIT-Mandi, Central University of Himachal Pradesh and the Association of Indian Universities.

The director said the theme of the event is 'Education for Development and Harmony with Nature'. He said the first five editions of Shiksha Mahakumbh were organised at various National Institutes of Technology across the country. These events played a pivotal role in fostering innovation, research, Indian knowledge traditions and a national educational perspective. They also contributed significantly to India's educational resurgence.

He said the three-day event would feature 16 multidisciplinary international conferences and eight national conclaves, including the Startup Conclave, Vice-Chancellors' Conclave and Scientists' Conclave.

These programmes would facilitate expert discussions on science and technology, education, health, the environment, Indian knowledge traditions, entrepreneurship, defence and other important sectors.

Speaking on the occasion, Shiksha Mahakumbh national coordinator Arti Sharma said the event would promote research, innovation and critical thinking among students of Classes 9 to 12 through 'Shodhankur', a student research journal. She added that 223 research papers had been received for the event. She said Punjab Governor Gulab Chand Kataria would inaugurate the event on the first day. Former Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur would be the chief guest on the second day, while Himachal Pradesh Governor Kavindra Gupta would be the chief guest on the concluding day. Other dignitaries invited to the event include Dr Rajiv Bhardwaj, MP; Anurag Thakur, former Union Minister; and Dr Sikander Kumar, Rajya Sabha MP.

NIT Registrar Dr Archana Santosh Nanoti, Shiksha Mahakumbh Convener Dr Shamsher Singh and Central University of Himachal Pradesh Controller Dr Jitendra Garg were also present on the occasion.

Doctor held with 8-gm chitta

DHARAMSALA, SEPTEMBER 5 A 32-year-old doctor working at a private hospital was arrested after the Crime Investigation Agency (CIA) of the Kangra police allegedly seized 8.03 gm of heroin (chitta) from his possession during a late-night checking on September 4.

Acting on a tip-off, the CIA team intercepted a car (HP39D6429) near Hanuman Mandir Ghat on the bypass road, under the jurisdiction of the Kangra police station. During the search, the contraband was recovered from the car driver, identified as Dr Shaurya (32), a resident of Old Chari Road, Kotwali Bazaar, Dharamsala.

The police seized the contraband and the vehicle. A case has been registered at the Kangra police station under the provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psy-

chotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, with further investigation underway.

The police are working to trace the source of the contraband and establish the identity of its intended recipient.

As part of their strategy, the police are focusing on stricter checking drives and surveillance, particularly during late-night hours. Officials have also indicated that violations such as drunk driving and other traffic offences will be dealt with strictly in order to enhance road safety and maintain public order.

Kangra SP Kulbhushan Verma has appealed to residents to immediately report any suspected involvement in the illegal drug trade or other unlawful activities. The police have assured that the identity of informants will be kept strictly confidential.
