

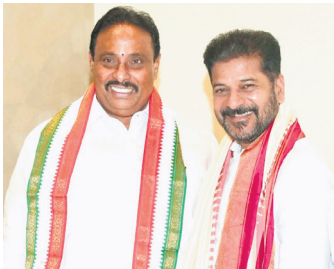
T'gana HC sets aside speaker's order, disqualifies Cong MLA

State plans agency for agri biz on lines of Guidance TN

THE Telangana High Court on Friday set aside the order passed by the Assembly Speaker, acting as Chairman of the Tribunal under the Tenth Schedule, in the defection case involving Congress MLA Danam Nagender and declared his Assembly seat vacant.

A bench of Chief Justice Aparesh Kumar Singh and Justice GM Mohiuddin allowed separate appeals filed by BJP Legislature Party leader Alletti Maheshwar Reddy and BRS MLA Padi Kaushik Reddy, challenging the Speaker's decision. The Registry was directed to communicate the judgment to the Speaker and the EC. The petitioners had sought Nagender's disqualification, contending that he was elected to the Assembly

on a BRS ticket in the 2023 polls, subsequently joined the Congress and, while still an MLA, contested the 2024 Lok Sabha elections as a Congress candidate. According to them, these actions attracted disqualification under the anti-defection provisions. Following directions issued by the SC, the Speaker, in his capacity as Chairman of the

Tribunal, conducted an inquiry into the complaints and held that Nagender had not incurred disqualification on the ground of defection. Aggrieved by the finding, Maheshwar Reddy and Kaushik Reddy approached the HC through separate petitions. After hearing the rival submissions, the bench had reserved its orders and pronounced its judgment on Friday, setting aside the Speaker/Tribunal's order and disqualifying Nagender as an MLA. Counsel appearing for Nagender subsequently requested the bench to suspend the operation of its order for some time to enable him to approach the SC. Counsel for the petitioners opposed the request, contending that once the court's disqualification order was pronounced, Nagender could not continue as an MLA even for a minute.

THE state is preparing to launch an Agri Business Guidance Bureau modelled on Guidance Tamil Nadu - the state's investment promotion agency - to give farmers, agripreneurs and farmer-producer companies (FPCs) structured access to technology, credit and subsidies, said Chandrasekhar Sakhamuri, director of TN Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business.

The bureau will be housed within the TN State Agricultural Marketing Board and launched with an initial state allocation of ₹50 lakh, Sakhamuri said at a

stakeholder consultation on agri-export logistics organised by the Confederation of Indian Industry and Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC), themed "From Farm Gate to Global Markets".

He said it is designed as a one-stop centre covering adoption of modern farming technology, linkage to institutional credit, subsidy access, crop insurance enrolment, investment planning and preparation of Detailed Project Reports required for bank loans or government funding. Separately, the state will offer a 50% capital subsidy, capped at ₹10 lakh per

FPC, to help farmer organisations buy electric refrigerated vehicles, aimed at cutting post-harvest losses. A pilot covering five FPCs, with a combined outlay of ₹50 lakh, will run in 2026-27; each eligible FPC will receive one vehicle.

The scheme targets faster, better-preserved movement of fruit, vegetables and flowers from collection centres to regulated markets, Uzhavar Sandhais, processors, organised retailers and institutional buyers. Sakhamuri said reliable, affordable and timely capital for farmer producer organisations, paired with stronger farm-gate

processing and preservation, is central to linking TN's agricultural value chains to export markets. FPOs should shift from a production-led marketing model to a market-led production model, he said.

On the sidelines of the event, Santosh Sinha, MD of CWC, said the corporation is planning its first hyperloop freight trial in Mumbai, to test high-throughput container movement as a next-generation logistics option. CWC has placed an order with TuTr Hyperloop, an IIT Madras-linked start-up, for the trial, and is evaluating a pilot route between the port and a CWC facility in Mumbai.



TN govt seeks 20 days to decide on crop loan waiver

The Tamil Nadu government on Friday informed farmers staging an indefinite protest at Samayapuram that it would decide on their demand for a full crop loan waiver and other poll promises.

As the protest entered the fourth day, the government invited them for negotiations.

A delegation of farmers, led by Eesan Murugasamy, coordinator of the Tamil Nadu All

Farmers' Associations, and P Ayyakannu, president of the Desiya Thenninhiya Nathigal Inaippu Vivasayalig Sangam, met a group of ministers and officials in Chennai.

Speaking to *TNIE*, Murugasamy said, "During the meeting, we explained the plight of the farmers and how they would benefit if the government completely waived crop loans. The ministers sought 20 days' time to decide on waiving the full crop loan."

GCC INTENDED TO ENABLE BUSINESS FUNCTIONS OF WALGREENS GLOBALLY

CONTINUED FROM PAGE 1: These firms are drawn by Chennai's software engineering talent pool and, in Walgreens' case, its established healthcare and life-sciences ecosystem. The GCC is intended to support enterprise-wide tech & business functions of the group globally. The Walgreens MoU follows the state's unveiling in the Assembly of a GCC Corridor and Development Programme, designed to steer new capability centres toward designated employment corridors across Chennai as the sector expands beyond its established base in the city. The programme covers three key corridors — Pallavaram-Thoripakkam Radial Road, Mount-Poonamallee High Road and Rajiv Gandhi Salai (OMR). Earlier this week, the CM had signed an MoU with Ernst & Young (EY) in the UK to facilitate the establishment, operation of a GCC in TN on behalf of a UK-headquartered telecommunications firm, which would generate 2,000 high-value jobs. Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Tuesday described TN as a major GCC hub, saying the state had 350 GCCs, accounting for about 10% of the country's total.

'Impaired canine reduced captured tiger's ability to hunt in wild'

ON August 21, another farmer, K Ravikumar (51), met a similar fate while working near his home. Subsequently, the forest department declared the animal a "man-eater" based on the nature of the attacks and evidence that it had fed on the victims. A team led by P Devaraj, DFO, Gudalur Division, consisting of more than 200 forest personnel, was deployed to locate and capture the animal,

supported by four kumki elephants from Mudumalai, drones, and camera traps installed at over 200 locations across the Gudalur Forest Division and adjoining ranges.

Multiple cages with live bait were strategically placed in vulnerable spots, including tea estates and forest fringes. The operation faced multiple challenges, including difficult terrain, dense vegetation and intermittent rains, but the teams continued with round-the-clock

monitoring and combing operations.

Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden of TN Rakesh Kumar Dogra confirmed that the captured tiger was responsible for both killings. "The male tiger captured in Gudalur has been clearly confirmed to be the animal involved in the deaths of two people, based on analysis of scat samples at the

Advanced Institute for Wildlife Conservation (AIWC) in Vandalur. The tiger, estimated to be around 11 years old, is an ageing animal with an impaired canine, which has compromised its ability to hunt in the wild," he told *TNIE*.

Dogra further said that a committee constituted as per the National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) protocol, comprising the field director and experienced

veterinarians, inspected the tiger and advised that it is not fit to be released in the wild. "Following the NTCA committee's recommendation and its protocols, the tiger was immediately shifted to Vandalur Zoo, as prolonged confinement could cause injuries," he added. Meanwhile, the successful trapping of the tiger has brought relief to the residents of O-Valley and surrounding areas, who had been living in fear for weeks.



Man kills mother over domestic dispute, held

A 60-year-old woman was allegedly murdered by her son following a domestic altercation at Aranemailu village within the limits of Hadadi Police Station in Davanagere taluk on Thursday night.

The deceased has been identified as Prema, while the accused, Anand, is her son. According to police, Anand allegedly assaulted his mother and repeatedly slammed her head against a wall while under the influence of alcohol, resulting in her death.

Superintendent of Police Dr H.T. Shekhar said Anand had been working in Mysuru and had recently returned to his native village for the Ganesh festival. Since his arrival, he had reportedly been involved in frequent quarrels with his mother, which eventually culminated in the fatal incident.

The SP said both Prema and Anand were allegedly in an in-

toxicated state at the time of the incident. During the altercation, Anand is said to have banged his mother's head against a wall, causing fatal injuries.

After the incident, Anand allegedly fell asleep beside the body. Police said that on Friday morning, Anand initially attempted to portray himself as innocent and claimed no involvement in his mother's death. However, during questioning, he allegedly confessed to the crime.

The accused was immediately taken into custody and produced before a court, which remanded him to judicial custody. An autopsy was conducted on the body, following which it was handed over to the family for the last rites.

Police said the exact motive behind the crime is yet to be established.

Hadadi police have registered a case and launched a detailed investigation into the incident. Further investigation is under way.
