MVA yet to finalise strategy as Mahayuti has problem of plenty

WITH THE Election Commission of India (ECI) announcing the schedule for the biennial election to five seats of the Graduate and Teachers' constituencies in the Maharashtra Legislative Council, the ruling Mahayuti is facing the problem of plenty to select candidates while Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) is yet to even initiate formal meetings for the same.

These five seats include sitting members Satish Chavan of NCP the Aurangabad Division Graduates constituency, Arun Lad of NCP(SP) from the Pune Division Graduates constituency, Abhijit Wanjari of Congress from Nagpur Division Graduates constituency, Kiran Sarnaik (Independent) from Amravati Division Teachers constituency, and Jayant Asgaonkar of Congress from Pune Division Teachers constituency.

In Pune Teachers constituency, Shiv Sena led by Eknath Shinde has staked claim to the seat, with the party's Mangesh Chivate and Dr Sachin Sanap campaigning for it. From Mahayuti, the BJP is likely to stake

claim. From MVA, Congress is likely to repeat Asgaonkar.

In Pune Graduate constituency, sitting MLC Arun Lad had contested from the NCP and after the party's split, he sided with NCP(SP). However, Lad's son, Sharad, has now joined the BJP and has staked claim to the seat. However, the NCP has demanded the seat saying Lad had contested and won the election as party candidate. NCP minister Hasan Mushrif has announced Pratap alias Bhaiya Mane as candidate for the seat. From the opposition, the NCP(SP) is likely to field Harshada Deshmukh-Jadhav, daughter of party leader Prabhakar Deshmukh.

Satish Chavan of NCP from the Aurangabad Division Graduates constituency is likely to re-contest. According to sources, BJP — which has increased its strength considerably in recent local body polls — has also decided to stake claim to the seat. From MVA, the NCP(SP) is a frontrunner while Shiv Sena (UBT) is also hopeful for the seat.

With Kiran Sarnaik (Independent) from Amravati Division Teachers constituency aligning with Shinde Sena, he is likely to re-contest the seat. BJP

hopefuls include Sangeeta Shinde-Bonde and Sumit Pawar. Even as Sena (UBT) has unilaterally announced the candidature of Dattatraya Lahane, ally Congress is likely to field Aditi Pohre, daughter of former minister Harshvardhan Deshmukh.

Abhijit Wanjari of Congress from Nagpur Division Graduates constituency is most likely to be renominated from the party, while BJP faces an internal fight, with two former legislators Sudhakar Kohale and Anil Sole staking claim.

"There are some seats where two out of three parties are interested to contest. The issue will be resolved once we meet. We will hold the meeting in three-four days and contest the polls unitedly," said a senior Congress leader when asked about the coordination within the MVA.

From Mahayuti too, negotiations and seat discussions are far from being over. "There are multiple candidates with each party. The picture will be clear only after we meet and decide," said a leader from the NCP. Voting for five constituencies will be held on October 23. The term of the sitting members will expire on December 6.

Sugar production may fall 20% to 80 L tonnes if crushing starts Oct 15: Raju Shetti

MAHARASHTRA'S SUGAR production this season could decline by nearly 20 per cent to around 80 lakh tonnes if the crushing season begins on its scheduled date of October 15, Raju Shetti, president of the Swabhimani Shetkari Sanghatana said on Wednesday.

Shetti told The Indian Express that an early start to crushing would hurt recovery rates significantly. "If the sugar crushing season starts on October 15, the sugar production may likely get reduced this season by around 20 per cent to nearly 80 lakh tonnes," he said.

Maharashtra has produced nearly 99 lakh tonnes of sugar in the past season of 2025-26 and the crushing season commenced on November 1.

According to Shetti, cane crushing if started on October 15 would yield a recovery rate of only around 7 per cent, whereas the same cane, if crushed from second week of November, could mature and yield a recovery rate of 9 to 10 per cent. On pricing, Shetti said, "Ex-mill sugar rates are expected to rise to around Rs 55 per kg during the upcoming festive season."

PUNE DIVISION

50 of 2,132 water samples found unfit at railway stations

AS PART of a special drive launched following observations in the Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) report on sanitation facilities and passenger amenities at railway stations, the Pune division of Central Railway tested 2,132 drinking water samples in August and September. Of these, 50 samples were found to be unfit, following which corrective measures were taken and the samples were retested and found fit, according to the press release issued by the Pune Railway Division on Tuesday.

The release mentioned that the CAG audit had not flagged any station in the division specifically over drinking water quality. However, following directives issued by the Railway Board, it undertook a comprehensive inspection of drinking water installations across its stations, railway colonies and workplaces.

The special drive covered 1,401 locations, including water sources, filtration plants, underground and overhead tanks, PVC tanks, water booths, taps and dispensing points.

During the inspections, officials recorded seven cases of

pipeline leakages. All seven were subsequently rectified, with no work remaining pending, the division said.

The drive also covered 1,382 water tanks located on platforms, station premises, railway colonies and office premises. According to the division, all 1,382 tanks were cleaned during the inspection period.

The 2,132 water samples collected during the drive were subjected to physical, chemical and bacteriological testing. While 50 samples were initially found unfit, the division said the deficiencies were addressed. It further said that after the corrective action and retesting, no bacterial or E. coli contamination was detected in the tested samples.

The division has also instructed its field units to maintain a regular schedule for water-quality testing and tank cleaning. E. coli testing kits have been provided at the offices of the concerned Inspectors of Works (IOWs), while the complete water-piping network is being checked for leakages.

Water coolers have also been inspected by the Electrical Department. The exercise included replacing leaking or missing taps and removing accumulated silt.

MONEY LAUNDERING CASE

HC questions framing of charges against Malik pending plea for ED documents

THE BOMBAY High Court on Wednesday questioned how charges could have been framed against former minister and NCP leader Nawab Malik in a money laundering case by the Enforcement Directorate (ED), while his plea seeking the list of documents in the agency's custody which were not filed with the charge-sheet was pending before the court.

A single-judge bench of Justice Milind N Jadhav was hearing Malik's plea challenging the September 25, 2025 order of the special court that rejected his plea for documents "vital" for filing discharge application, after the agency denied having them with it.

Advocate Kushal Mor, appearing for Malik, stated that despite the ED counsel's statement, charges were framed in

November 2025. Another High Court bench had granted an interim stay on proceedings in December 2025, which was extended from time to time.

Mor informed Justice Jadhav that the court permitted Malik to amend his plea and challenge the framing of charges on the ground that the documents were not provided. Requesting deferral of proceedings before special court, Mor claimed the ED had referred to these documents to oppose Malik's bail without including them in the chargesheet.

He added that one such document goes to the "root of the matter" and would undermine the ED's case.

"How can the charge also be framed when this thing (plea over documents) is pending?" Justice Jadhav orally responded.

Mor said that as per the agency, there was a fire in its office building affecting the documents in the case.

IIT BOMBAY STUDENT SUICIDE

Family says police tried to move them out of Mumbai; cops deny

A DAY after IIT Bombay student Sahil Wakode's father announced that he would begin a hunger strike if there was no arrest in the case registered over the death by suicide of son, his lawyer on Wednesday alleged that Mumbai Police tried to take the Wakode couple out of the city against their wishes.

Police, however, denied the allegation, saying the couple had themselves asked to be taken to Yavatmal.

The allegation came a day after Ravindra and Sonali Wakode addressed the media outside the IIT-Bombay main gate and demanded action in the case. Their lawyer, Nikhil Kamble, said the couple had planned to stay in Mumbai but were taken away in a private vehicle early Wednesday.

"I saw that they were asked to get into a private car in a rush.

Wakode's plan was to remain in the city. But despite their plan, the police tried to forcibly take them out of Mumbai," Kamble alleged. He said the couple had initially been travelling in their own vehicle but were asked by police personnel in plain clothes to shift to another car. "They were told by the official that he was taking them home," he alleged. According to Kamble, the

couple had reached Washim district by early Wednesday. He said the move appeared to have followed their interaction with the media on Tuesday evening.

The parents had earlier in the day recorded their statements before the Crime Branch in Bandra and later addressed the media outside IIT-Bombay.

Ravindra Wakode had said he would begin a hunger strike

from Wednesday if there was no arrest in the case.

A Mumbai Police officer denied that the family had been forcibly taken to Yavatmal. The officer said that after the couple addressed the media near the Crime Branch office in Bandra, they told police they wanted to go to IIT-Bombay in Powai.

"They told us that they wanted to be taken to Yavatmal and hence we organised the same," the officer said. The officer also denied that the couple was taken out of Mumbai because the father had threatened to stage a hunger strike.

The Wakodes have alleged that their son was subjected to caste-based discrimination on campus.

Meanwhile, protests inside and outside IIT-Bombay continued for the fifth day on Wednesday, even as regular classes resumed on campus. A section of students continued their sit-in protest inside the campus.

Committee set up to examine circumstances around death

AMID MOUNTING pressure from the protesting students after the death of 20-year-old Sahil Wakode, IIT Bombay Director Professor Shireesh Kedar said on Wednesday that the Board of Governors has set up a 10-member committee to examine the circumstances surrounding the alleged suicide on September 18.

He said, "The committee will be headed by Dr Ramesh Venkateswaran," who serves as the Chairman of the Board of Governors, IIT Palakkad.

Meanwhile, a sharp divide among sections of IIT Bombay students has come into focus over Professor Doolla's suspension — a common demand from all students has been for an independent and transparent investigation by the institute into the entire episode.
